SAINT AGNES

Saint Agnes was born in 291 into a Roman family of nobility and raised in a Christian family. She suffered martyrdom for her faith and commitment to her virginity as a young teen on January 21, 304. In art she is often portrayed holding a lamb, a symbol of innocence. Saint Agnes is the patron saint of young girls.




Ukrainian Easter Egg **Art Workshop**

Ash Wednesday 6:15 PM Mass Announcement


At the 6:15 PM Mass on February 14, music will be in English, Chant Mass will be the form in which the congregation can participate in the parts of the Ordinary of Mass. What does this mean? Latin Chant will be sung. According to the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops document "Sing to the Lord", the Second Vatican Council directed that the faithful be able to sing parts of the Ordinary of the Mass together in Latin. To facilitate active participation, a worship aid will be available at this Mass. It is a small portion of Mass that will be in Latin, the majority will be in the vernacular, or English. To further assist those

unfamiliar with Latin chant, please go to our parish website for videos and instruction.




