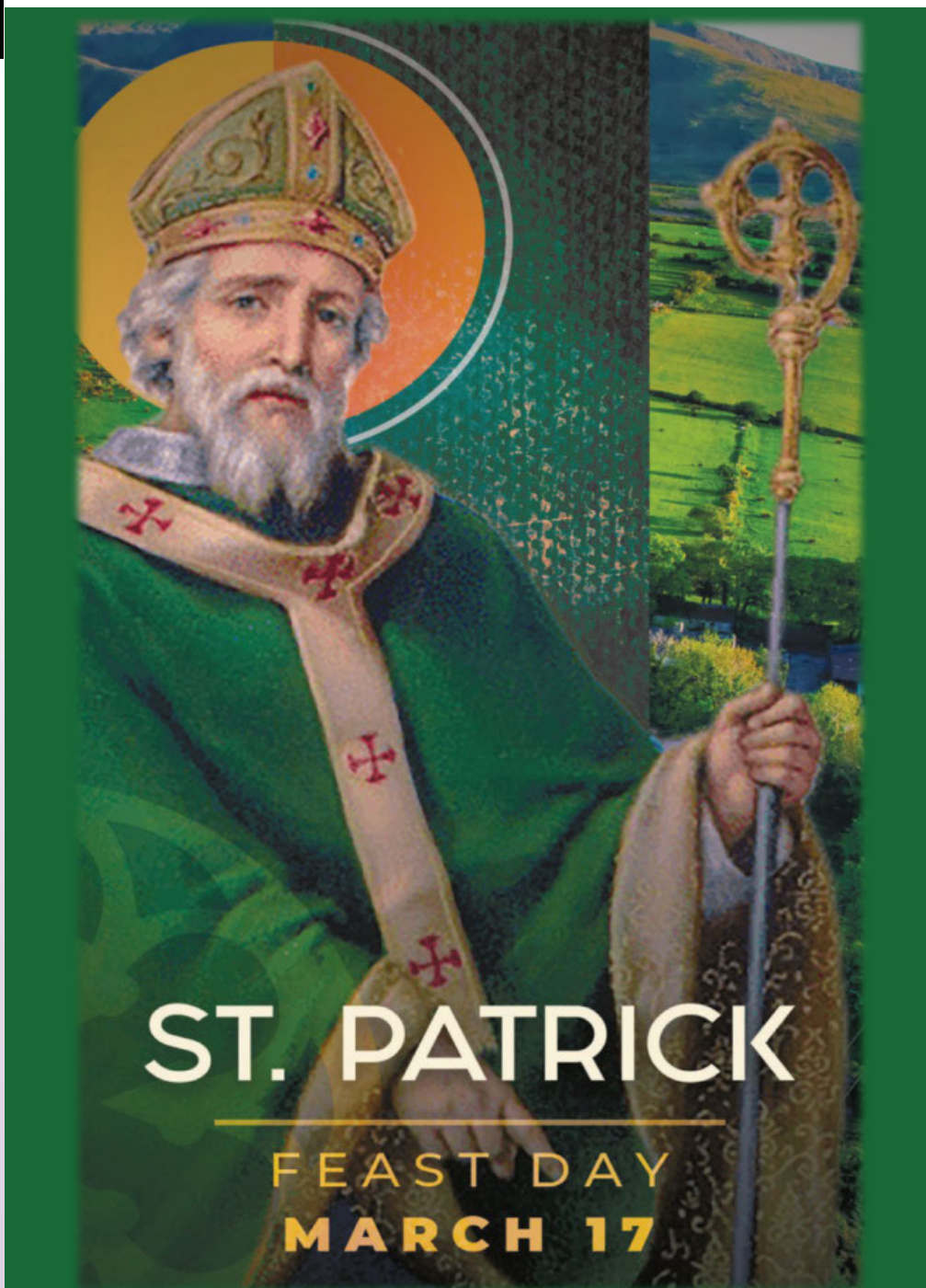

SAINT AGNES

Saint Agnes was born in 291 into a Roman family of nobility and raised in a Christian family. She suffered martyrdom for her faith and commitment to her virginity as a young teen on January 21, 304. In art she is often portrayed holding a lamb, a symbol of innocence. Saint Agnes is the patron saint of young girls.

From St. Agnes Safety and Security

St. Agnes Parish has value for all of us parishioners in a multitude of ways. We come to worship, engage our faith, put our beliefs into action, join hearts and minds to show love and care for others to name only a few of the blessings we enjoy.

However, St Agnes is not an isolated island but rather we are woven into the fabric of our neighborhoods, community and beyond.

Over the past decades, we have felt the impacts of extreme weather, increasing incidents of violence, varying threats to individual and family safety.

We are very aware of how churches have been targeted by people compelled to perpetrate violence on the very sanctity of places of worship. And yet, by the numbers, 80 % of the emergencies in places of worship are related to health issues. After all, in case you haven't noticed, we are not getting younger!

Given this developing reality, Fr. Patrick asked the parish to form a Safety and Security committee in early 2019. The first meeting took place on May 23, 2019. This group includes members of church staff, building and grounds committee and ushers.

They wrote this mission statement: Strive to balance the values of our place of worship while optimizing safety and responding appropriately to emergencies.

The following are accomplishments resulting from their efforts:

- Increased the number of ushers and greeters.
- Identified Lead Ushers to help raise awareness of and responsiveness to emergencies.
- Developed a security manual to provide instructions for various emergency responses and the location/use of appropriate equipment.
- Ushers are positioned to best monitor all safety aspects for parishioners.
- Church doors are secured after Mass begins to provide control.
- Coordinates with other parishes and the diocese for consistent responses and best practices.
- Conducted several training sessions on Sept 25, 2019 and Oct 14, 2023.
- Training sessions focused on proper CPR techniques, First Aid practices and the use of a defibrillator (AED).
- Our surveys have shown the greatest concerns include preparations for First Aid, Fire Safety/evacuation, proper handling of bloodborne pathogens and skills for calming a person in distress.
- Trainings are scheduled for April 14 and April 24, 2024.
- The goal of the St. Agnes Safety Committee is to provide these areas of training annually thereby raising the level of knowledge and readiness.
- Our plan is to use our weekly bulletin and Mass announcements to keep parishioners informed.
