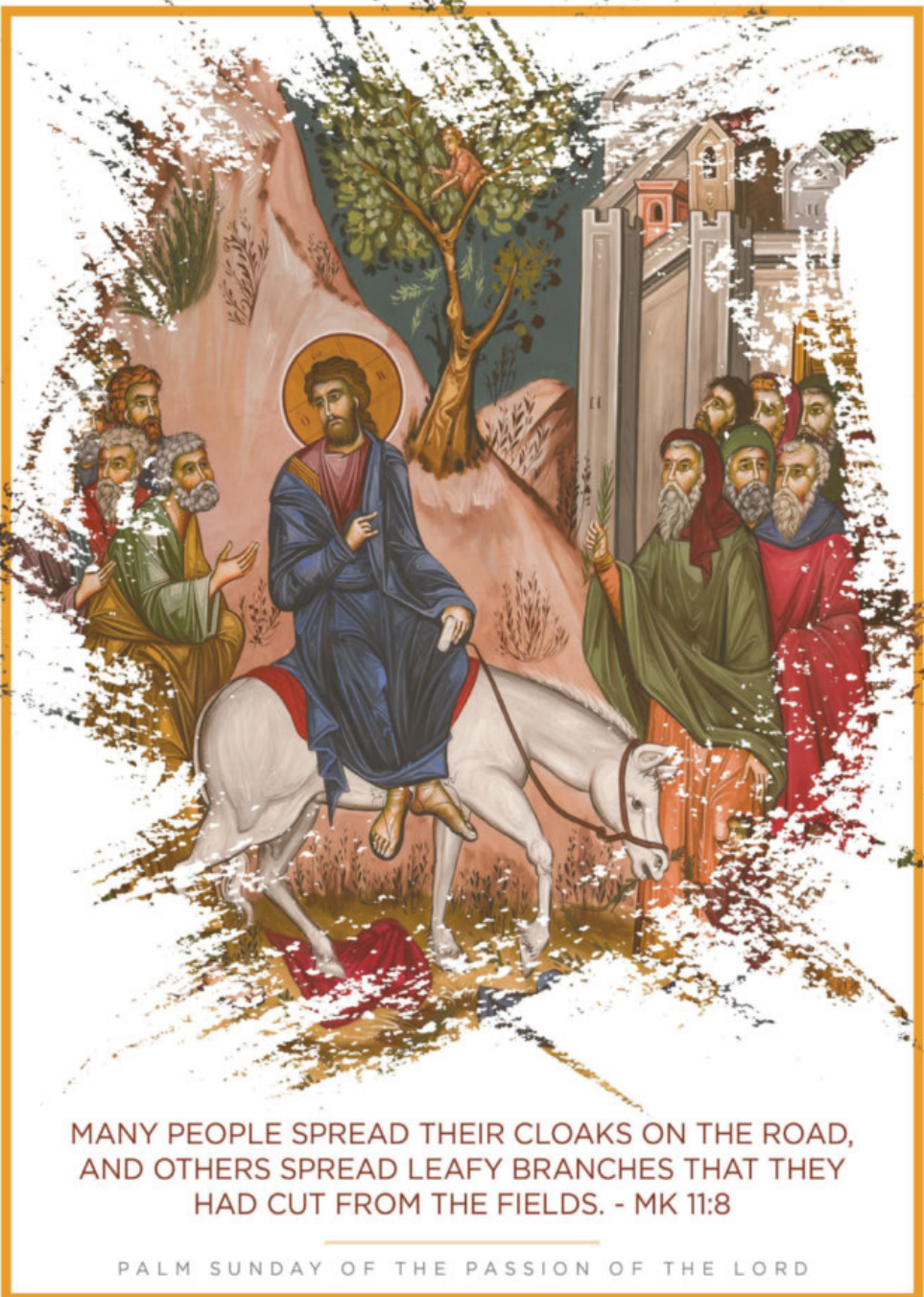

SAINT AGNES

Saint Agnes was born in 291 into a Roman family of nobility and raised in a Christian family. She suffered martyrdom for her faith and commitment to her virginity as a young teen on January 21, 304. In art she is often portrayed holding a lamb, a symbol of innocence. Saint Agnes is the patron saint of young girls.

Come Let us Adore

Is there anyone alive who wants MORE noise in their life?
Aren't all of us searching for real peace...and quiet?

There is an answer.

Eucharistic adoration.

Saint Catherine Laboure' reminds us that silence is a masterful teacher for it is in the stillness that God speaks. She said, "Whenever I go to the chapel, put myself in the presence of our good Lord and I say to Him, 'Lord, I am here. Tell me what you would have me do.'...and then I tell God everything that is in my heart. I tell Him about my pains and my joys, and then I listen. If you listen, God will also speak to you, for with the good Lord, you have to both speak and listen. God always speaks to you when you approach Him plain and simply."

Our parish needs you and you need adoration. That's about as plainly and simply as I can say it.

We have the beautiful opportunity to spend time alone with Jesus with about 20 hours per week available 3 weeks a month and an added 24 hour Adoration every First Friday.

Bishop Ricken has asked us to step up our efforts utilizing the opportunity not only for a personal relationship with Jesus but to specifically pray for an increase in vocations to the Priesthood and religious life in our Diocese.

In the same spirit as Jesus asking His friends to pray with Him in the Garden of Gethsemane, we are asking for more parishioners to step forward and share in the work of redemption through spending one hour a week in Eucharistic Adoration.

If you are interested please contact the parish office or talk to me or Dawn Toonen. We particularly need men to come forward for the night time hours on First Fridays.

Our regular hours are:

Tuesday: 7:30 am-noon

Wednesday: 8:30 am-5:45 pm

Friday: 1-5 pm

(First Fridays...7:30 am-8 am Saturday)

So many Saints have taught us of the power of a Holy Hour. So many vocations are as a direct result of time spent alone with Jesus. So much healing has occurred while in adoration.

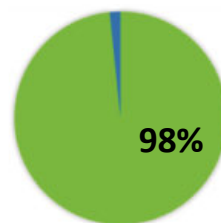

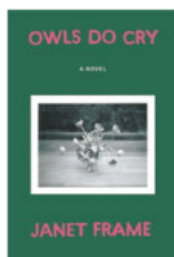

What is Divine Mercy?

Divine Mercy is the form God's love takes when it flows from the Trinity to his creatures. It takes on human flesh in Jesus Christ to show us God's love. This is why Divine Mercy is a Person, not just an attribute of God.

What is the Message?

God loves us - all of us, no matter how great our sins. Remember your **ABC's** as a way to live out the message of the Divine Mercy and Gospel.

Ask for God's mercy - God wants us to repent and ask for His mercy.

Be merciful to others - God wants us to receive His mercy and in turn, be merciful to others.

Completely Trust in Jesus - Trust in God during good times and bad times.

The **Divine Mercy Novena Prayer** begins on Good Friday and is a good way to prepare for Divine Mercy Sunday.

The **Divine Mercy Chaplet** is prayed on ordinary Rosary beads. The Chaplet is powerful because it draws in its strength from the Mass. It is normally prayed at 3:00 pm because Jesus died on the cross for us at this time.

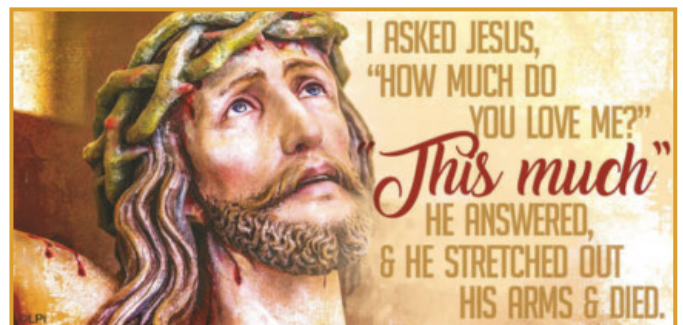

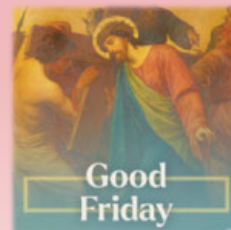
