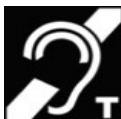

SAINT AGNES

Saint Agnes was born in 291 into a Roman family of nobility and raised in a Christian family. She suffered martyrdom for her faith and commitment to her virginity as a young teen on January 21, 304. In art she is often portrayed holding a lamb, a symbol of innocence. Saint Agnes is the patron saint of young girls.

To Those Hospitalized, Home Bound or in Nursing Homes

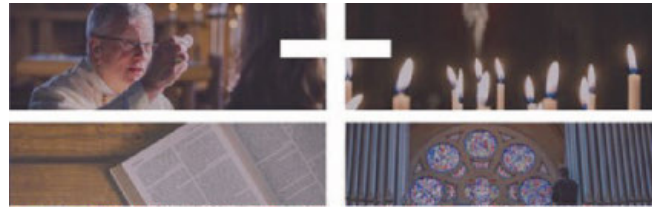

From the Office of Divine Worship

Summer Workshops for Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion

Beginning in June, the Office of Divine Worship, in partnership with parishes throughout the diocese, is offering a second round of Liturgical Ministry training for parish ministers on the Vicariate level. These workshops will focus on training those who already serve as Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion as well as those who wish to begin volunteering in this ministry. Below is the link address to register, and I will email a live link to our current ministers of Holy Communion. If you are interested in becoming a new distributor of Holy Communion here at St. Agnes, please contact the parish office or myself and we'll see that you receive our own training as well as the Vicariate training.

Unlike other lay liturgical ministers, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are to be commissioned for this ministry by the Bishop. This commissioning is preceded by proper and sufficient spiritual, theological, and practical preparation to fulfill their role with knowledge and reverence. This formation is ordinarily provided by the Office of Divine Worship.

Please note: These courses will be the same as those offered last Fall so if you attended then, you are not required to go this summer; additional enrichment courses will be offered in 2025 for those who wish to learn more.

GOSPEL MEDITATION

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

4th Sunday of Easter

Jn 10:11-18

Recently I was with my little dog Libby at a retreat center in the Arizona desert. I sat in a chair near a ravine filled with shrubs. Unbeknownst to me, Libby wandered down there and disappeared. Suddenly an animal's wild shriek erupted from the area. Without thinking, I bolted down into the ravine fully expecting to see coyotes, javelinas, or rattlesnakes. I didn't care. I desperately wanted to get Libby out of there, without any self-regard. Before I could face whatever danger lay hidden, my dog blissfully trotted out from an entirely different area, utterly unaware that I had (quite heroically) just placed my life on the line.

When the adrenaline wore off, I thought to myself: how far would I have been willing to go to save her? I don't know. But I do know, if I had literally died, my friends and family would have certainly thought me insane for dying for a dog. No offense, Libby.

How passionately Jesus wants us to know him and his willingness to die for us! This week he says, “**I know my own and my own know me,**” and “**I lay down my life for the sheep.**” Here we encounter an insanely excessive love for us. Christianity is a relationship and not simply a religion or ethical code. In Jesus, God rescues and saves us. He laid down his life for you and me — and he has taken it up again. So often we are like Libby — blissfully ignorant of the reality of both our spiritual danger and his saving love. This Easter season, the risen Jesus calls us to be more conscious than ever before about his love. He never ceases to lay down his life for us.
