SAINT AGNES

Saint Agnes was born in 291 into a Roman family of nobility and raised in a Christian family. She suffered martyrdom for her faith and commitment to her virginity as a young teen on January 21, 304. In art she is often portrayed holding a lamb, a symbol of innocence. Saint Agnes is the patron saint of young girls.

Sacrament of Reconciliation

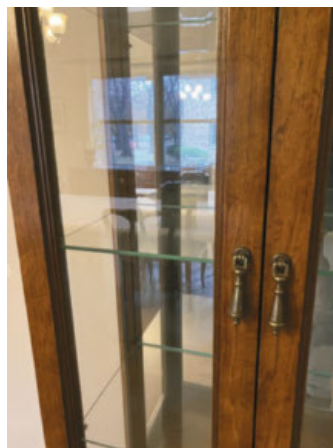
You can see that the construction of the car port has come along quite a bit from last weekend. Last Monday we did a little prayer after the 6:45 Mass. You might remember that about a couple years ago I did a blessing at all the weekend Masses with all the Intentions Books we had from years past. This is the book we have on a table in the narthex. We had about a dozen of them going back 20 years. At the time I commented that those books were full of thousands of very important prayers, concerns long in the past now. So when we did that prayer in the Masses it was one last time to appeal to the providence, care, and mercy of God. With the construction going on we had the opportunity to bury those books which we did with a little prayer and some of the 6:45 Mass attendees present. It also served as an opportunity to bless the construction workers that morning, for their work, their safety, and their families.

Dear St. Agnes Members:

Our prayer of thanks to the Lord is what a wonderful thing it is when St. Agnes parishioners continue to reach out to help the Hope Center Pantry clients. Each of you do not get direct credit from the Pantry clients that are helped out by being the recipients of your regular food donations. The Pantry clients receive this food and there is no expectation from any of you of ever having the favor returned. We hope that those we serve at the Pantry in some way do what they can to find a way to help others in this world. This chain of human beings so willing to offer up ways to help each other must really please the Lord. And although the hand we extend to help someone, and the hand that receives it, may never touch, we have to believe that the scales will balance. Somewhere, someday that other hand will reach out to smooth the way for somebody else. Lord, don't let any of us ever forget those who have given us a lift along the way. Let no day pass that we don't help somebody else. It's the Christian way to repay those who have helped us.

This past month of March the Pantry was able to provide a substantial amount of food to 338 families which is comprised of 1,111 people (516 of these were children). Looking back over the past six months, St. Agnes parishioners donated 555 bags of food to the Pantry. Each bag contained an average of 10 food items. That's a substantial contribution to the success of the Pantry and the amount of clients we can serve. We are grateful for your continued generosity in helping those in our local community who need food assistance.

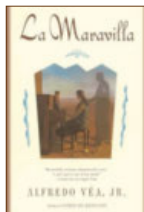

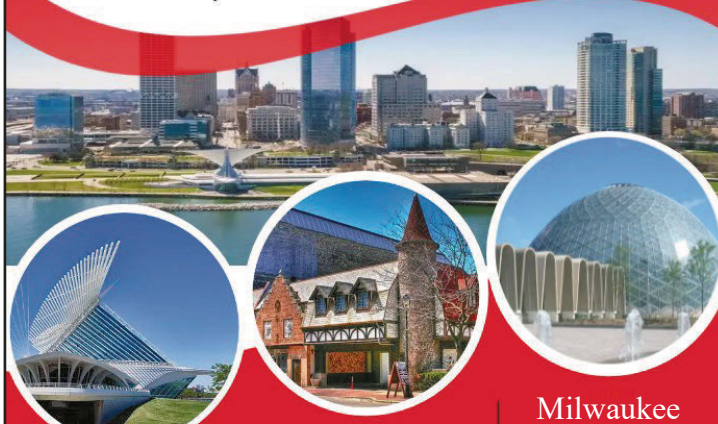


Who can be anointed? (Canon 1004)

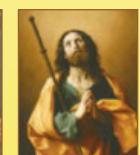
