SAINT AGNES

Saint Agnes was born in 291 into a Roman family of nobility and raised in a Christian family. She suffered martyrdom for her faith and commitment to her virginity as a young teen on January 21, 304. In art she is often portrayed holding a lamb, a symbol of innocence. Saint Agnes is the patron saint of young girls.

Next week, we will take up the Home Missions – Our Own Needs collection for the support of the missions in the United States. *Envelopes are provided in your bi-monthly packet and at the church doors. You may choose to support all four organizations or any one. Make checks payable to St. Agnes Parish.*

The four major beneficiaries of this collection:

Black and Indian Missions exists to build Christian communities among the Native American, African American, and Alaskan Native people. Annually, in our Diocese, we receive grants to assist our parishes in Neopit and Keshena with outreach, education, and service to the people of the Menominee Indian Tribe.

The Catholic Communications Campaign (CCC) modernizes how the Church communicates the joy of the Gospel nationwide and locally. Half of all funds collected for the CCC remain in our diocese to support local communication efforts.

The Catholic University of America is the National University of the Catholic Church. Your gift enables the University to prepare the next generation of Catholic leadership, both religious and lay.

The Catholic Home Missions assists 40% of dioceses in the United States. Poverty, distance, difficult terrain, and lack of priests significantly affects the ability of mission dioceses to offer basic pastoral needs. Home Missions provides financial assistance for Mass, sacraments, and faith formation.

- 2. "This sacrament can be repeated whenever the sick person again falls into a serious sickness after convalescence or whenever a more serious crisis develops during the same sickness."







Mass Stipend Update

The 2025 Parish Mass Calendar is open for the scheduling of intentions from January through today's date in 2025. The current Mass stipend is \$10.

The Mass stipend has remained the same for over thirty years throughout the Dioceses of Wisconsin. Recently, when the Bishops of the State of Wisconsin gathered, they decreed that stipends should be adjusted to reflect the current time. The new Mass stipend is \$20 and will be applied to all new Mass intention requests received as of July 1, 2024.


