Saint Agnes was born in 291 into a Roman family of nobility and raised in a Christian family. She suffered martyrdom for her faith and commitment to her virginity as a young teen on January 21, 304. In art she is often portrayed holding a lamb, a symbol of innocence. Saint Agnes is the patron saint of young girls.

Praise the Lord! Growing up on the water in Sturgeon Bay had a lot of advantages. One of them being specifically created by God for my mother. That great gift was for her to have the ability to send us out the back door and leave us to our own devices. The water was the playground, and we would be out of her hair for the whole day. She had the freedom to do her thing and we had freedom to do ours! One rule, however, was non-negotiable -- if you were by the water you had to practice the buddy system. She actually did say, "You have to practice the buddy system."

In this weekend's Gospel, Jesus sent them out two-by-two. Interesting, isn't it?! Jesus had them practice the buddy system. They were to watch out for one another, journey with one another, pray with each other. What the one experienced the other would share and vice versa. There is strength in numbers. The Gospel also relates that where there are two or more, there is [Jesus] in our midst. There are plenty of spiritual dangers out there already, folks. Let's not try to "go it alone." Remember, friendship is at the heart of a relationship. Friendship, comradery, fraternity, solidarity are all Catholic Christian practices that help us not to have to face the dangers alone. We then look out for one another; we encourage each other and share with each other the joys and sorrows of this life. Mom's advice was so wise. We would do good to "practice the buddy system." Seems that our Lord knows what He's talking about! He also knows that the gift of freedom necessitates having someone along for the ride. The perils are many but the joy that comes is unparalleled. Just like those summer days on the water with a friend. **Now & Forever!**

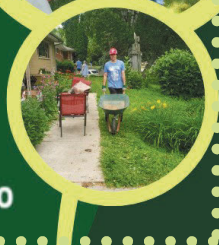
