

SAINT AGNES

Saint Agnes was born in 291 into a Roman family of nobility and raised in a Christian family. She suffered martyrdom for her faith and commitment to her virginity as a young teen on January 21, 304. In art she is often portrayed holding a lamb, a symbol of innocence. Saint Agnes is the patron saint of young girls.

Praise the Lord! Perhaps you are wondering what the AMDG stands for on the top of my bulletin article. It is the Latin initials for, "For the Greater Glory of God." In Latin it is *Ad maiorem Dei gloriam*. *A.M.D.G.* It was a term coined by St. Ignatius of Loyola. He is the founder of the Jesuits. To give God the glory is the primary activity of mankind. Well, it is supposed to be. Usually what ends up happening in our lives is that we begin to glorify something other than God. We glorify power, pleasure, prestige or money. We can often begin to glorify ourselves. If we don't glorify God, we begin the slippery slope of the glorification of things of the world. To give God the glory is the entire focus of Mass. It may be something we can begin to forget. To give God the glory gives us the perspective we need in life. Primarily it means that the right order of our lives is to place God first. The fourth commandment: Keep holy the Sabbath Day is about setting aside a day to glorify God. In fact, the first four commandments all have to do with God's glorification. The first commandment is: Thou shall have no strange gods before me. We can see then that the focus is to keep God as a priority of our lives. The glorification of God then is serious business because it will rightly order our lives. In today's Gospel there are fragments left over after feeding the multitudes. Sometimes we have fragments of our lives left over. There are "pieces" of our lives where we have not allowed the glory of God to shine through. Perhaps we can reflect upon those places today. Jesus has them taken up and used. He doesn't allow anything to go to waste. He knows with sadness in his own heart that there are pieces of our own lives that need to be picked up. There are parts of us that are scattered and the light of Christ has not penetrated our hearts. In essence, we are not completely giving God the glory. Jesus' entire mission on earth was to glorify His Father. So it stands to reason that the glorification of God should be our mission too. We may be startled to learn that there are entire baskets to be filled up in our lives. There are innumerable places in our lives that have yet to be sanctified so as to begin the glorification of God. Mass is the primary place whereby God is glorified. It is at Mass where we keep our Sabbath holy. Mass is the place where the fragments are gathered up and placed in a basket so to say. This large hold of our lives together then await a new heaven and a new earth. A place where heaven and earth meet to glorify God and not ourselves. Now & Forever!

Grade 7 Volunteer Needed


The St. Agnes Religious Education Program is in need of a Grade 7 catechist on Wednesday evenings




