## **SAINT AGNES**

Saint Agnes was born in 291 into a Roman family of nobility and raised in a Christian family. She suffered martyrdom for her faith and commitment to her virginity as a young teen on January 21, 304. In art she is often portrayed holding a lamb, a symbol of innocence. Saint Agnes is the patron saint of young girls.

## **Clarity in Teaching**

Welcome to September! In our first reading this weekend, Moses pleads with the Israelites to stick to the law as God declared it, not tweaking it or adding technicalities. He assured his people that observing God's laws would bring them great benefits down the road. Next, St. James gleefully encourages his audience to "welcome the word that has been planted in you...." His call to action focuses on acting charitably toward orphans and widows and to keep oneself unstained by the world.

The Gospel of Mark features a powerful response from Jesus after the Pharisees complain about his disciples neglecting to wash their hands before eating. Jesus cuts through their hypocrisy with beautiful clarity by instructing that true defilement comes from within oneself. Without honest discernment we might become blind to the very vices that corrupt our hearts, such as deceit, envy, greed, and others. It's an important warning to the Pharisees and all of us that God, who is Love, knows our hearts intimately, and will not accept our adherence to sin.

As we prepare to begin our religion classes on Wednesday nights, I am reminded of the lists of beliefs and laws that our students endeavor to learn. We teach about the Ten Commandments, Eight Beatitudes, the gifts of the Holy Spirit, and so on. These lessons are good for students to understand, but I hope there is an even deeper level of learning here. Inspired by the clarity in which Jesus taught, hopefully we can help students draw closer to God by avoiding vices and embracing their Catholic faith without reservation.

I am grateful for the parishioners who stepped forward to teach classes with us this year, as well as the volunteers who help us manage the classrooms, hallways, and parking lot. We simply could not teach the next generation of Catholics without them. I would also like to thank the Catholic Foundation of the Diocese of Green Bay for their support in the purchase of workbooks from Sophia Institute for Teachers. Grades 1 – 8 will be using "Spirit of Truth," which promises to be a thoughtful and engaging series.
