Saint Agnes was born in 291 into a Roman family of nobility and raised in a Christian family. She suffered martyrdom for her faith and commitment to her virginity as a young teen on January 21, 304. In art she is often portrayed holding a lamb, a symbol of innocence. Saint Agnes is the patron saint of young girls.

Praise the Lord! Sometimes the answer we look for comes in the most unexpected of places. Inspiration may come from an unlikely place at any given time. The challenge is to be able to discern the movement of God in our lives so that we are prepared to see Him. Sometimes a change of scenery or a switching up of routine can enable us to see things more clearly. I remember struggling to solve algebra story problems when I was a freshman in high school. I would read it over and over again without any luck as I was doing my homework. It was winter and in frustration I bundled up and walked outside. Since we were on the bay, I walked out on the ice and looked up and saw the clear bright stars above and breathed in the crisp cold fresh air. Coming back inside, I set about to finish up and sure enough, I was able to complete my homework. In our lives as Christians sometimes we sort of stare at real life story problems. For the life of us, we just can't seem to make sense of what is before us. The words on the page begin to blur and before you know it, we just can't seem to make things aright. Answers, however, come from the most unlikely of people and places. In the first reading Eldad and Medad were not part of the camp, "yet the spirit came to rest on them also...." Jesus likewise says of those driving demons out in His name, "Do not prevent them." Sometimes the solutions to our problems will come in unexpected and the most unlikely times, places and people. The task for us then is to be attune to the truth that God wants to impart. The psalmist says, "The precepts of the Lord give joy to the heart." Taking time out of our week to pray and be with God helps us to see the action of grace in our lives. Prayer helps us to see God in the most unexpected of times and most unlikely of people. Prayer gives to us a chance to look up and see clearly, to take a deep breath and go back and "hit the books," so to say. The task at hand is met with clarity and truth. Knowing the Truth of Christ in our lives helps us discern the hidden truths that can be revealed through the most inconspicuous of moments. Our prayer can be, "Lord help me to be open to the grace you want to impart to me for whoever is not against us is for us." **Now & Forever.**

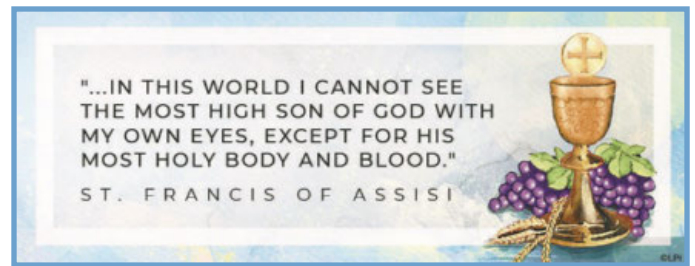

Dear Parishioners:

We are now offering low gluten hosts as an option for those with Celiac disease and the like. The "low-gluten" host cannot be mistaken for "NO-gluten" host. The low gluten host contains .002% gluten or <20ppm. Our low gluten hosts are ordered through Dewitt Church Goods and provided by a company called Regal. They are produced in strict adherence to Canon Law. A sacrament has two aspects. Its form and substance. The substance of the Eucharist species of the host is required to be bread. Hence the low gluten flour and water to make the host a valid substance. Irritable bowel syndromes vary widely so please consult with your doctor about your specific condition to know if the above percentage is low enough for you. Lastly, the low-gluten host does not come in contact with the rest of the regular hosts at *any time*. We have a special separate sacred vessel to hold the low-gluten host both in the Tabernacle and on the ciborium. If you require a low gluten host, please receive Most Holy Communion in the priest's communion line as he will have the special separate ciborium with the low-gluten host. It is helpful to come before Mass to let the priest know you will be receiving the low gluten host. Thank you and may God's peace be with you.
