

Saint Agnes was born in 291 into a Roman family of nobility and raised in a Christian family. She suffered martyrdom for her faith and commitment to her virginity as a young teen on January 21, 304. In art she is often portrayed holding a lamb, a symbol of innocence. Saint Agnes is the patron saint of young girls.

#### The Kingdom of God Belongs to Such as These

Wild animals, marriage, angels, siblings, and children. Today's readings use all these elements and more to deliver profound messages about the nature of our place in God's plan. We start off with a vivid narrative from the Book of Genesis that brings the first man and woman together, establishing marriage.

The Letter to the Hebrews explores the difficult concept of the death that Jesus experienced for our salvation. In his suffering and death, Jesus changed our status forever; we are no longer bound by death, but we become his brothers and sisters for eternity. We tend to think of our siblings in the finite framework of our family on earth, but our siblings are truly all baptized people and Jesus Himself.

Mark's Gospel ends with a scene that I wish I could have witnessed in person. Jesus welcomed the little children after the disciples had tried their best to shoo them away. He tells them, "The kingdom of God belongs to such as these." It's a powerful message about the value our Lord places on the lowly among us. Children, with their lack of guile or worldly status, simply want to love and be loved. That is what we were created for. Our complicated adult lives make it difficult to remember this truth, but we can't discard it, or we risk distancing ourselves from God.

This October I look forward to a retreat experience with the RE students in Grades 6 – 10. We will participate in an event put on by the Green Bay Diocese that focuses on the life of Blessed Carlo Acutis. Still a teenager when he passed away in 2006, Carlo Acutis is an excellent role model for students because he embraced his devotion to the Eucharist and skillfully learned how to use technology for a good purpose without becoming a slave to it. The retreat will offer guest speakers, a Rosary procession, Adoration, and Mass. Through the years I have heard from people who recall how a specific retreat experience was the catalyst in their spiritual journey. Before the retreat they were lukewarm in their faith, and after, well let's just say they were sure that God had a plan for them, and they needed to trust in Him. Please pray that our students may come back from this retreat with joy and purpose in their hearts.

#### Dear Parishioners:

an option for those with Celiac disease and the like. The "low-gluten" host cannot be mistaken for "NO-gluten" host. The low gluten host contains .002% gluten or <20ppm. Our low gluten hosts are ordered through Dewitt Church Goods and provided by a company called Regal. They are produced in strict adherence to Canon Law. A sacrament has two aspects. Its form and substance. The substance of the Eucharist species of the host is required to be bread. Hence the low gluten flour and water to make the host a valid substance. Irritable bowel syndromes vary widely so please consult with your doctor about your specific condition to know if the above percentage is low enough for you. Lastly, the low-gluten host does not come in contact with the rest of the regular hosts at any time. We have a special separate sacred vessel to hold the low-gluten host both in the Tabernacle and on the ciborium. If you require a low gluten host, please receive Most Holy Communion in the priest's communion line as he will have the special separate ciborium with the low-gluten host. It is helpful to come before Mass to let the priest know you will be receiving the low gluten host. Thank you and may


