

Saint Agnes was born in 291 into a Roman family of nobility and raised in a Christian family. She suffered martyrdom for her faith and commitment to her virginity as a young teen on January 21, 304. In art she is often portrayed holding a lamb, a symbol of innocence. Saint Agnes is the patron saint of young girls.

Praise the Lord! A thank you to all those who have kept me in prayer during my recovery from hip surgery. I am especially grateful to those who have sent get-well cards or have expressed their kindness through food and company. This has reminded me that there are so many that go through health scares and crises. We continually are being made aware of our dependency upon God and our need for others to care for us. I am particularly independent and have that streak of rugged-individualism coursing through my veins, so this recovery has been particularly humbling. Physical therapy once a week plus "take-home PT work" is going smoothly. The regiment every day between the means of recovery, rest, and eating well has been pretty steady. I've had friends and family visit me in the rectory. This has been a particular blessing. I am grateful to be here at Saint Agnes during this time. Lastly, I want to express my gratitude to Fr. Rich, Fr. Phil, Fr. Luke, Fr. Teddy, Fr. Mark, Fr. Zach, Fr. Paul, Fr. Erick, & Fr. Patrick Beno for their help in covering varying Masses. Also to Dcn. Dan, Dcn. Greg, & Dcn. Conrad for helping with reposition of the Blessed Sacrament.

Next weekend kicks off the Bishop's Appeal. I would like to thank you in advance for your generosity in supporting the Bishop's Appeal for 2025. Of course, we know the appeal comes out annually, but the consistent effort of so many of our parishes to help the greater Church is tremendous. Saint Agnes is no exception. 
