Saint Agnes was born in 291 into a Roman family of nobility and raised in a Christian family. She suffered martyrdom for her faith and commitment to her virginity as a young teen on January 21, 304. In art she is often portrayed holding a lamb, a symbol of innocence. Saint Agnes is the patron saint of young girls.

Speaking of kindness, I would like to again express my gratitude to many who have offered prayers for me during recovery as well as those who have provided sustenance along the way. I have my second follow up with the surgeon on the 16th and by the 19th I may be allowed to begin doing strength training. Things are progressing well and continued prayers are appreciated. I have an entirely new appreciation for so many that undergo surgery.

The Gospel reading for this weekend gives us an understanding of how Jesus is sought by others for healing. The particular line in the scriptures of the people pressing against Him is a remarkable insight for us to ponder. Maybe there was some shoving and pushing going on in this scene. There are many vying to get closer and in effect pushed others away. Often times we may lean into something rather than Someone. We can easily "press the issue," so to say and try to barrel our way through a particular ordeal or a specific suffering. This is common in our lives. Sometimes we must press on and endure what may come our way. However, that may become intolerable at some point and time. We may be pressed with impending deadlines, a certain apprehension about a conflict that must be resolved between a family member or a friend. Peter's exclamation is very poignant. He declares, "Depart from me Lord, for I am a sinful man." When we feel pressured or have been pressed in our lives, Peter's statement offers us an answer to our need. We can simply express our shortcomings to the Lord. We can make an honest and forthright statement about our own condition. In this way, we move toward Jesus without pressure or being pressed into Him. Rather, we are gently pressed close to His heart of love. We inevitably receive a consolation or a keen insight into truth and are finally healed in His proximity. Now & Forever!


Be with those whose spirits are exhausted by the quest for health doubt the existence of love question the fairness of life or stare into the face death.


# St. Scholastica
