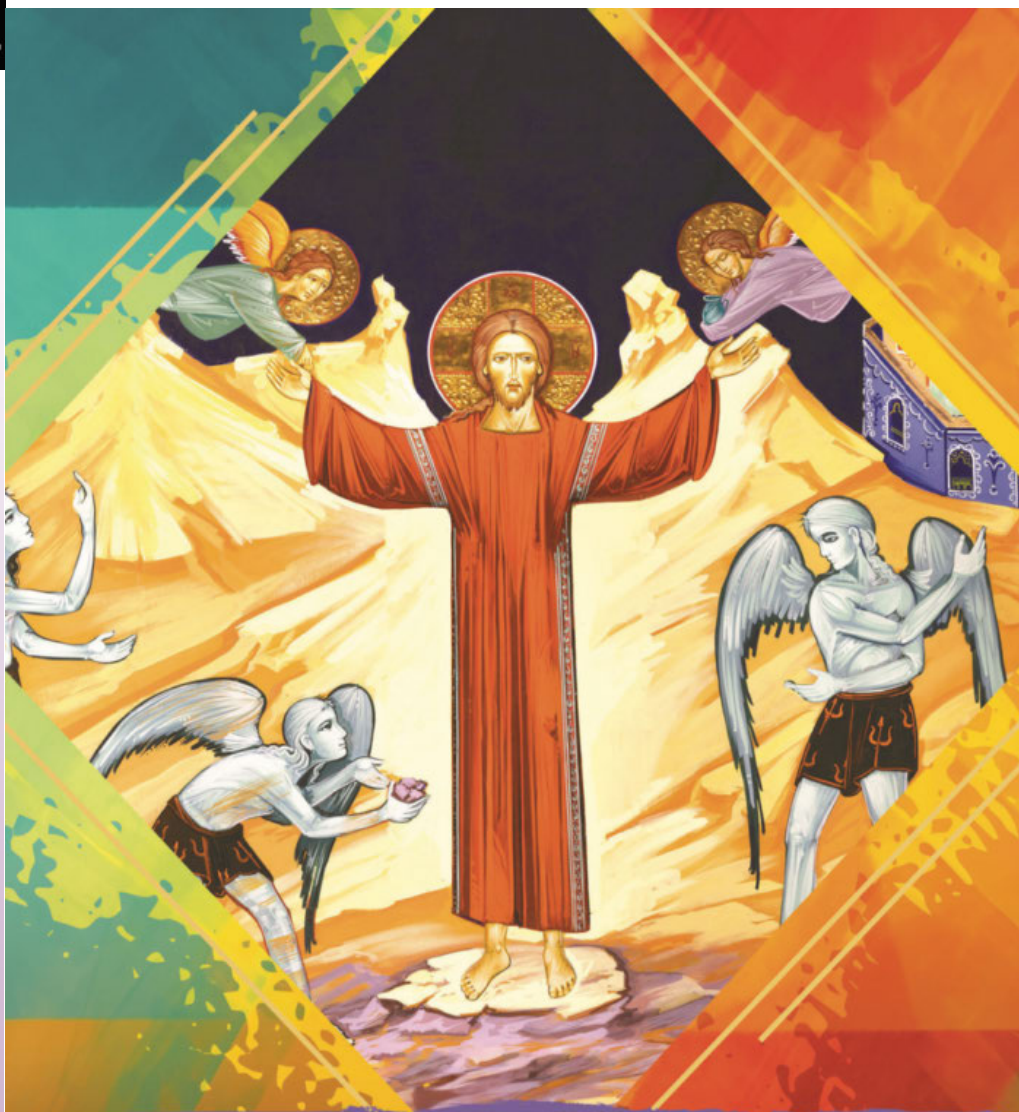

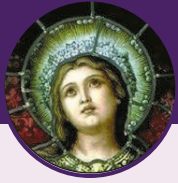

In art she is often portrayed holding a lamb, a symbol of innocence. Saint Agnes is the patron saint of young girls.

Give thanks to the Lord! Today marks the first Sunday of Lent. It should come to no surprise that the month of March often gives way to the beginning of this new liturgical season. However, there are other things happening in March that may be more commonly celebrated in our culture. For instance, we have the day before Lent, Mardi Gras. Originally its intention was to have one last celebration before entering into prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Or we may be familiar with Saint Patrick's Day as celebrated on March 17th commemorating the evangelization of Ireland by Saint Patrick. Last but not least, there is March Madness. This college basketball tournament captivates a vast audience of sports enthusiasts every year. With either sports or the secularization of a saint, we often think of luck as a large component of the festivities. A team may need luck to win the tournament coupled with skill and hard work. We know of course the cliché of, "the luck of the Irish." Either way, luck plays a big part in our everyday lexicon when it comes to the month of March.

However, there is no luck when it comes to the Lenten season. We don't wish one another "good luck," or say to one another, "Well good luck with that." The journey of Lent is not so much about any sort of luck but has much more to do with resolve, determination, will and pure spiritual grit. On Ash Wednesday we heard, "Repent, and believe in the Gospel," or, "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return". Our interior lives are not predicated upon luck. There is no such thing involved with taking on this sojourn seriously. When we attempt to truly enter into Lent, our dependency is upon God's grace to become more real in our lives. We willfully make a decision to make the Lenten season not a season of luck, charm, or dare I say even madness. No, we march into the season willfully desirous of becoming sanctified, to be changed forever, and to prepare our hearts for Christ's resurrection from the dead. Lent is not for the faint of heart, but for those who take the ultimate chance of being changed forever. Wishing you all the best Lent you have had yet.

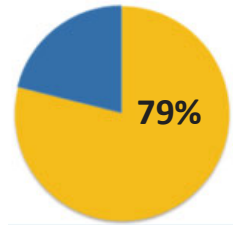
