

In art she is often portrayed holding a lamb, a symbol of innocence. Saint Agnes is the patron saint of young girls.

Give thanks to the Lord for He is good! Hard to believe that we are already in the third week of Lent. Of course, it went a bit faster for me as I had the chance to go down and watch the Brewers play in Cactus League. Arizona was very dusty. I was comparing the dust down there to the dust of the salt we have on our roads at this time of year. The wind will blow and stir it up. It can get in your mouth and you taste it. Lent is a time of dust. Of course we received ashes which is a type of dust. Recently even Texas was in the news for severe dust storms that disrupted highways. We hear this in the Gospel this weekend, "Sir, leave it for this year also, and I shall cultivate the ground around it and fertilize it; it may bear fruit in the future." When I arrived at the Brewers Field, it was far from dusty. Of course, you had the dust of the diamond, but there was lush green grass. You could smell the cut of the new grass with the sunshine. We have here, of course, two images. Dust and fertile soil. Jesus really has a way with words because this can be the state of our souls at any given time. We can accumulate a bit of dust. We may become embittered or angry. Perhaps we hold a grudge or are hurt and unable to forgive. At times like this, Lent seems to be the most appropriate place for us to be. We are in the dust and the dirt; the desert. Every so often, however, we find a diamond in the rough so to say. There is a ground that is fertile and green. This is the refinement of these days of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. They say baseball is a bit eternal. There is no time clock to rule the game, it can just keep on going. Maybe we can ask the question: Have I gotten dusty and down? Is there a place where I can be renewed and refreshed? Have I become exhausted and tired? Do I need to cultivate the ground I find myself on? Be assured of my prayers for you these days of Lent. God bless you.



DID YOU KNOW?

There are Ordinary Ministers and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion.

Ordinary Ministers are the ordained – bishops, priests and deacons.

Extraordinary Ministers are the lay (nonordained) members of the church.

- The ordained serve as the principal ministers of Holy Communion. When there is a truly large number of the faithful gathered, the priest may call upon Extraordinary Ministers to assist him.
- The ministry of the Extraordinary Minister compliments and extends that of the ministry of the ordained. Extraordinary Ministers, therefore, are to be commissioned to assist in the distribution of Holy Communion at Mass.
- An Extraordinary Minister should never take the place of an available Ordinary Minister.

These sessions will clarify what Vatican II teaches in contrast to various claims about the Council. You will be prepared to charitably discuss Vatican II and the various changes to the liturgy which occurred following the Council.
