



Looking to save taxes on your Required Minimum **Distribution while helping St. Matthew?**

If you have to take a required minimum distribution from your IRA because you are over age 72, you can donate some or all of your required minimum distribution to St. Matthew (and other charities) and avoid paying tax on that amount. Your broker or IRA custodian must send the money directly from your IRA to St. Matthew. (That is, you can't take the money out and write a check to St. Matthew later. It must be a direct transfer.) Check with your broker or IRA custodian for more information.

A Message from Fr Ryan:

In the Creed we confess that Jesus "will come again in glory." The Second Coming of Jesus is central to our Faith. We must believe it because it grounds our hope in the life that he has promised to give to those who are faithful to him.

Jesus' first coming was as an infant at Christmas. Many people were expecting the Messiah to enter the world with a flourish – a bombastic display of power, authority, and salvation for the Jewish people. The only problem was that God never promised he would come among them in exactly that way. They had projected their own expectations on God and, as a result, they totally missed out on his coming among us.

Jesus promised us that he would come again, but this time it would be unmistakable. He describes scenes of great comfort – and of great terror – when he comes again "in all his glory, and all his angels with him" (see Matthew 25). If we have lived the kind of life he commanded at his first coming, we will be filled with awe and joy at his arrival! Next week, I'll talk about what he will do at that second coming - "judge the living and the dead."
