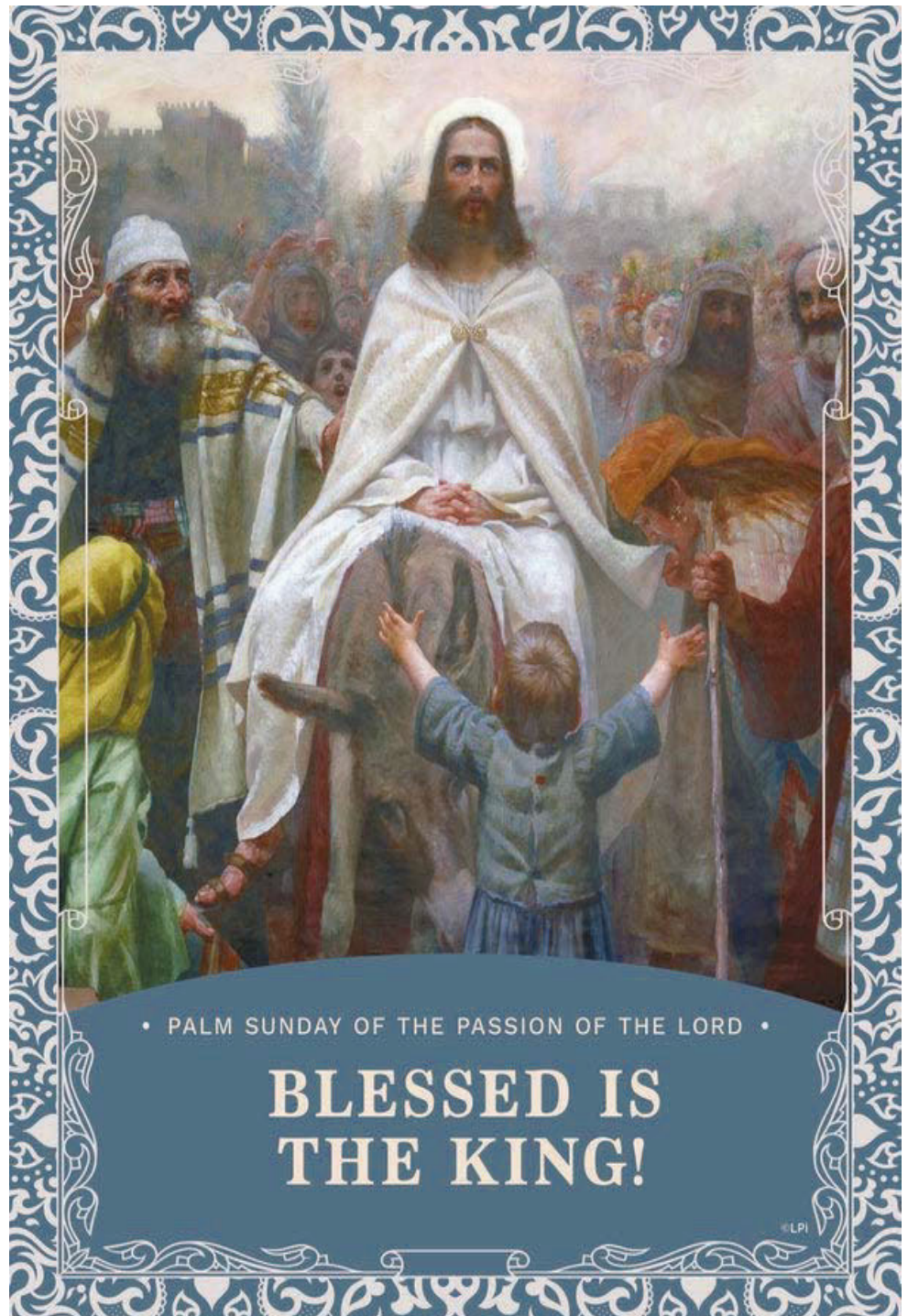

THOUGHTS FROM YOUR PASTOR

We enter into the Most Holy Week of our Liturgical Year today. As Jesus enters Jerusalem to shouts of Hosannas, we embark on remembering HIS Life, Death and Resurrection, which is called the Paschal Mystery. A lot of important and meaningful days are ahead of us. I can only INVITE you and your family out to these Holy and Important Days.

On Tuesday we are called to gather as one at the Chrism Mass in the Sportscenter at 6:30. It is the one time throughout the year we are called to come together to show our unity as Catholic People. During this Mass, I along with the other priests, renew our Priestly Vows. It's also where the Bishop blesses the oils that will be used throughout the year. If you have never attended this Mass, I strongly encourage you to come this year. That's 6:30 on Tuesday at the Sportscenter in Owensboro.

During our Holy Thursday Mass at 6:00 pm, we remember Jesus washing the feet of the disciples and giving us the Eucharist. I will wash the feet of 12 of our members. Our Liturgy ends with the Blessed Sacrament being taken to the Parish Hall for Adoration until 10:00 pm. This is one of my favorite Liturgies of the Year. Come out and help celebrate our Call to Service and the Body and Blood of Jesus.

Friday we reflect on the Passion/Death of Jesus. It is called to be a somber and quiet day. We will enter into an empty church. The Passion of our Lord will be proclaimed. We will adore the Cross and receive the Eucharist. We end our Liturgy in silence.

Then on Saturday we celebrate the Holy Saturday Liturgy. We bless the fire and bring in the Easter Candle. Then we have the telling of our salvation by way of Sacred Scriptures. We bless the New Water and renew our Baptismal Promises. We then remember the Last Supper. We leave being Resurrected People. The tomb is now Empty. Alleluia, Alleluia, HE IS RISEN.

On Sunday the Glorious Announcement is made that Jesus Lives. We celebrate the Easter Season for 50 days until we celebrate Pentecost Sunday.

Part of the Good News this year is that Spring Break is not the same week as Holy Week, which means we have no excuse not to attend these important days of our Liturgical Year. I promise you will be renewed in your faith if you attend. Let us celebrate Holy Week as the people God has created us to be in HIS image and likeness.

I hope to SEE everyone at church. Pray for me as I pray for you.

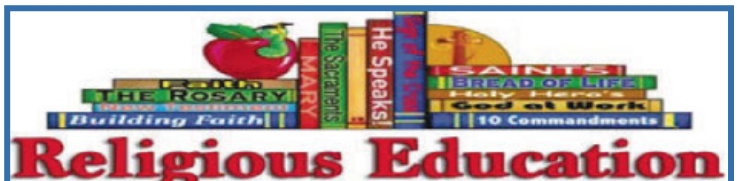

Let us pray that the use of the new technologies will not replace human relationships, will respect the dignity of the person, and will help us face the crises of our times.

"My God, my God, why have You abandoned me?"

We've never known the Jesus of the Gospels to doubt the will of God. We've never known him to give into feelings of despair. He's the hero who walks on water, the Savior who is welcomed to Jerusalem with a pathway of palms. And he knows how this story ends: he knows full well that his Father has absolutely *not* abandoned him.

So why does he say this? Jesus doesn't make off-handed comments, especially in his last hour. Today, when we repeat the words that he calls out in his darkest moment, we must remember that he wants us to consider them.

With his crucifixion, Jesus reminds us of his humanity. He is a man of flesh that can be torn and blood that can be shed. Somehow, in tandem with his divinity, he still possesses a heart that knows fear and pain and longing. And with this seemingly hopeless cry, he reminds us of that.

Let us never doubt that Jesus can relate to us in our brokenness. This is the week, friends. This is the week that reminds us that our God is a God who knows every pang, every trembling, and every uncertainty of human life. Our God knows what abandonment feels like. He knows what rejection feels like. He knows what it is to keep going when the strength and the will has disappeared.
