

From Our Pastor

Dear Missionary Disciples of Christ,

Here is some great news as we celebrate the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord and are reminded of our baptism taken from the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*, *2nd edition*:

"The fruit of Baptism or baptismal grace, is a rich reality that includes forgiveness of original sin and all personal sins, birth into the new life by which man becomes an adoptive son (or daughter) of the Father, a member of Christ and a temple of the Holy Spirit. By this very fact the person baptized is incorporated into the Church, the Body of Christ, and made a sharer in the priesthood of Christ." (1279)

"Baptism not only purifies from all sins, but also makes the neophyte 'a new creature,' an adopted son (or daughter) of God, who has become a 'partaker of the divine nature,' member of Christ and co-heir with him, and a temple of the Holy Spirit." (1265)

"The Most Holy Trinity gives the baptized sanctifying grace, the grace of *justification*:

- enabling them to believe in God, to hope in him, and to love him through the theological virtues;
- giving them the power to live and act under the prompting of the Holy Spirit through the gifts of the Holy Spirit;
- allowing them to grow in goodness through the moral virtues.

Thus the whole organism of the Christian's supernatural life has its roots in Baptism." (1266)

In addition, we have continually been paying down our \$1.85 million loan from the Archdiocese. We are approximately only \$340,000 away from paying off that loan due to your continued generosity during Covid.

Again, thank you all for the prayers, cards, gifts, and money I have received for Christmas.

NEW INITIATIVE AT SACRED HEART FAITH COMMUNITY NURSING (PARISH NURSE)

Last year I lost a very dear friend after an extended illness. She lived alone until the end of her life, and we both really enjoyed our weekly visits. When she passed away, I was praying one day and God put on my heart to start a parish nursing program at Sacred Heart. I am sure my friend was not the only person who may enjoy a visit, need help with resources, or want to feel connected to Sacred Heart even though they may not be able to attend Mass. So with Fr. Maassen's blessing starting in January, we will be rolling out a Parish Nurse Program.

What exactly is a Faith Community/Parish Nurse? It might help first to tell you what I am not. I am not a physician, so I won't provide medical diagnoses or medical treatment. I am not a home health nurse, so I will not provide the treatment prescribed by a physician (although I will be able to help someone get those resources). I am not a therapist so can not do physical or occupational therapy. I am not a clergyperson.

As a Faith Community/Parish Nurse, I will focus on the intentional care of the spirit as well as the promotion of health and the prevention or minimization of illness. I will do this by providing:

- Health education for someone recently released from the hospital with a new diagnosis;
- Health counselor that can discuss health concerns, encourage healthy lifestyle changes;
- Referral advisor if other services are needed such as home health, counselor, social services;
- Health advocate to find needed services or equipment that someone has been unable to locate on their own;
- Volunteer coordinator for help with rides to a medical appointment, meals during convalescence, or help with child care during an illness;
- Access to support groups within the parish and in the surrounding areas; and
- An ear to listen or a shoulder to lean on when someone is unable to be physically present at church and is seeking connection with the Body of Christ.

I am very excited to be starting this ministry at Sacred Heart. If you know of a parishioner at home or in an assisted living or skilled care facility, that might benefit from a parish nurse visit, or if you have any questions about the position and what we can offer, please call the parish at 636-225-5268, and leave a message.

Parishioners:

In November, Sacred Heart Catholic School was visited by a group of teachers, principals, and Archdiocese officials with the purpose of evaluating our School Improvement Plan. This group stayed two days and observed classes, met with school personnel, met with parents and board of education representatives, and celebrated Mass with us. The group wrote commendations for the school in three areas: Catholic Identity, Educational Issues, and Institutional Issues. I would like to share their commendations with you, the Parishioners. I want you to know that we have a wonderful school at Sacred Heart; it is always nice to hear this from people outside our community.

Educational Issues Commendations

The Visiting Team commends the Sacred Heart-Valley Park School Community for:

- The offerings of an academic lab to provide differentiated instruction to meet the needs of all students.
- The commitment of the teachers and parishioners to provide extracurricular after-school activities such as robotics, Speech Team, School Play, and Student Council.
- The practice of using i-Ready benchmark and Dibels Reading Test to identify specific areas and skills in need of improvement.
- The regular use of technology in the classroom and the I4 lab to enhance learning.
- The hiring of a STREAM teacher that allows students to create unique hands-on solutions to project challenges.
- The efforts of the learning consultant in working with students to master skills and provide enrichment opportunities.
- Enhancing technology usage in the classroom using document and digital cameras, IPads, Kindles, and laptops as well as using Google Classroom.
- The students' dedication to compete in the Robotic Program.
- The use of multi-level faith families to build a school community.
- The use of available space to strengthen technological learning with a STREAM Lab and Technology Lab
- The teachers for their use of holistic strategies to support student learning styles.
- The Priest for taking the time to meet with second graders to prepare them for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Communion.
- The Home and School organization for providing a stipend for each teacher to improve their learning in their classroom.
