Human life must be respected and protected absolutely from the moment of conception. From the first moment of his existence, a human being must be recognized as having the rights of a person – among which is the inviolable right of every innocent being to life. (2270, *Catechism of the Catholic Church, 2nd edition*)

Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, and before you were born I consecrated you.

My frame was not hidden from you, when I was being made in secret wrought in the depths of the earth.

Since the first century the Church has affirmed the moral evil of every procured abortion. This teaching has not changed and remains unchangeable. Direct abortion, that is to say, abortion willed either as an end or a means, is gravely contrary to the moral law: (2271)

You shall not kill the embryo by abortion and shall not cause the newborn to perish.

God, the Lord of life, has entrusted to men the noble mission of safeguarding life, and men must carry it out in a manner worthy of themselves. Life must be protected with the utmost care from the moment of conception: abortion and infanticide are abominable crimes.

Formal cooperation in an abortion constitutes a grave offense. The Church attaches the canonical penalty of excommunication of this crime against human life. “A person who procures a completed abortion incurs excommunication *latae sententiae*, by the very commission of the offense,” and subject to the conditions provided by Canon Law. The Church does not thereby intend to restrict the scope of mercy. Rather, she makes clear the gravity of the crime committed, the irreparable harm done to the innocent who is put to death, as well as to the parents and the whole of society. (2272)

The inalienable right to life of every innocent human individual is a constitutive element of a civil society and its legislation. (2273)

Since it must be treated from conception as a person, the embryo must be defended in its integrity, cared for, and healed, as far as possible, like any other human being. (2274)

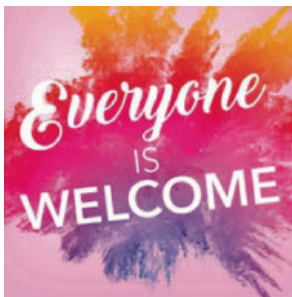

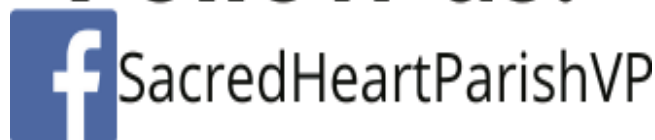

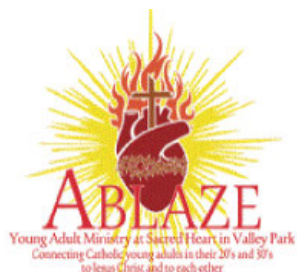

Institutional Issues Commendations

The Visiting Team commends the Sacred Heart-Valley Park Catholic School Community for:

- The efficient use of building space, i.e. The I4 Lab for STREAM/STEM Lab.
- The outdoor welcoming space with tables, a children's garden, and a prayer garden.
- The improvements of a new addition for a gym, classrooms, and administration offices.
- The installation of security cameras on the campus for safety.
- The installation of a water bottle filling station, hand sanitizing stations, and portable air filters to insure the health of students and staff.
- The attention to health and safety details through the School Emergency Standard Operating Guidelines, "Go Kits", and the training of faculty, staff, and students in emergency preparedness.
- The new fenced playground and a grass field which have been modified for all ages.
- The community engagement committee for creating a new, more informative website.
- The open house to reach parishioners with younger children.
- The change to FACTS as the main source of communication to school families.
- The sense of care and cleanliness of the school has a welcoming feeling.
- The color art displays representing Pre-K to Grade 8 enhances the school pride of the community.
