BUILD MY CHURCH

When we consider the Lord as the Good Shepherd, we see how He unites us as His flock, bringing us together under His protection. We know that He cares for each one of us more deeply than we can understand. In the parable of the lost sheep, Jesus illustrated how, when any in His flock lose their way, the entire flock must seek them out and surround them with God's grace and mercy.

In **John 21:1-19**, Jesus shows us that, if we entrust our efforts to evangelize the world to Him, they will always be fruitful, even when we lack understanding. As the disciples fished, unable to catch anything after hours and hours at sea despite their many years of experience, Jesus appeared and told them to simply fish from the other side of the boat. Following our Lord's direction, the catch was so large that it almost dragged their boat underwater.

Jesus, teaching the apostles to be fishers of men, then gave Peter a special responsibility. Because Peter had denied Jesus three times, Jesus gave him the opportunity to express his love three times. Then, he gave Peter the instruction, "Feed my sheep."

*"Peter was distressed that Jesus had said to him a third time, "Do you love me?" and he said to him, "Lord, you know everything; you know that I love you." Jesus said to him, "Feed my sheep. Amen, amen, I say to you, when you were younger, you used to dress yourself and go where you wanted; but when you grow old, you will stretch out your hands, and someone else will dress you and lead you where you do not want to go." He said this signifying by what kind of death he would glorify God."*

If we love Jesus, then we must in turn share His love with others. When we share God's grace and mercy with others in our community, we are blessed to experience it more deeply ourselves.

We, like Peter, are sinners, and we often underestimate our power as fishers of men. But when we serve the Lord and have faith, we can fill a community with His unending love. In **Acts 5:27-32, 40b-31**, as Peter stood before the Sanhedrin, the high priest told him, "You have filled Jerusalem with your teaching."

In the USA, abortion **takes the lives of more than 600,000 babies** a year. *Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health* could change that. The Mississippi law at stake in this case **bans abortion** after 15 weeks. The question before the Supreme Court is whether all pre-viability bans on elective abortions are unconstitutional. This is the case that could **overturn Row v. Wade** - The Supreme Court decision which made abortion legal in all 50 states. Nine justices stand between for millions of innocent children and their mothers.

Beyond personal prayer for the forthcoming ruling (expected in June or July), please consider joining parishioners in prayer weekly after the Saturday 8 a.m. mass, weekly Sundays at 8 p.m. Adoration or monthly at the Planned Parenthood Hour of Prayer from 11-12 p.m. (4th Saturday).

## ALBOTS ARE GOING GLOBAL!

While the team didn't receive any judges' awards at the FIRST Lego League World Championship in Houston last week, we can safely say this team from Valley Park did an amazing job and represented Sacred Heart and the state of Missouri well. Our robot finished 23rd out of 106 teams from around the world, placing us in the top 22%. We are so very proud of them!

The team isn't finished yet! The Albots received notification last Monday that they are one of 20 finalists for the 12th Annual FIRST Lego League Global Innovation Award (200 teams submit their projects and 20 are selected) that will be held June 21-23 in St. Louis. This means the Albots have one of the top 20 innovation projects in the whole world! This is the first time ever that the Albots have advanced to the finals for Global Innovation.



The Albots are ready to compete in Houston. Mr. Vise promised to spray paint his hair purple if the team made it to Worlds. He kept that promise!

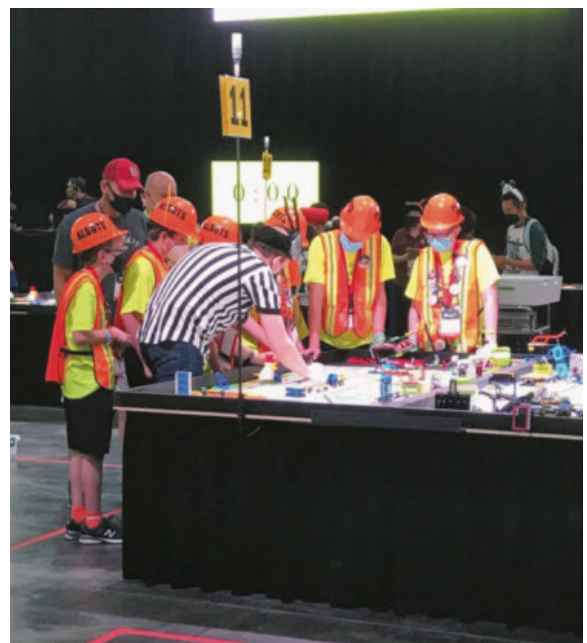
