THOUGHT FROM THE PASTOR. . . We read in the Letter to the Hebrews, "For if the blood of goats and bulls and the sprinkling of a heifer's ashes can sanctify those who are defiled so that their flesh is cleansed, how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself unblemished to God, cleanse our consciences from dead works to worship the living God." Today we celebrate the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. The Holy Eucharist is the source and summit of our faith. It is at the very center of everything we do. To be able to receive the Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ is a privilege granted to us that no one else can say they have. How do we thank the Lord for such a great gift? We do so by living a life that is worthy of such a gift. We love more we serve more and we forgive more in short, we let the light of Christ shine in our lives.

As of this printing we have several vaccines. (There has been some question as to if you can morally use the Johnson one shot vaccine the short answer is yes you can. However if you are given a choice and some times a choice may not be given you should choose either the Pfizer or the Moderner Vaccines) So there is hope that soon we can return back to some kind of normalcy but until then we continue as below:

As you know from the letter given to us by Bishop Robert J. McClory the Bishops of Indiana has suspended until further notice the obligation to attend Mass. This will come to an end on June the Eleventh, the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The Mass will be fully open. So I would encourage all who are able to come to Mass to please come and join us. Yes you can look at Mass on TV or on the computer but you would not be receiving Jesus. The reception of our Lord in the Eucharist is at the very core of who we are as Catholics. I could not image not being able to receive the Lord so PLEASE if you can come to Mass. The church is sanitized after every Mass and we take all precautions to keep you safe. So Come Join us the Mass is fully open.

Even though the CDC has lifted the face mask mandate for those who are vaccinated when in inside the Church has not. So we must without exception follow these few restrictions. These being we still must wear a facial mask and we still must practice social distancing. To keep our social distance we will only use every other pew this will allow for six square feet of social distancing. This will limit numbers so if you have a favorite Mass do not come late. This will be a first come first serve. So lets come back to Mass we miss you. We will continue to live stream the Mass as we have been doing..

ON SATURDAY, MASS IS AT 4:00 IN THE AFTERNOON. This will allow time for the proper disinfection of the building. No podía imaginarme no poder recibir al Señor así que POR FAVOR si pueden venir a misa La iglesia está desinfectada después de cada misa y tomamos todas las precauciones para mantenerlos a salvo. Así que ven a unirse a nosotros la misa está completamente abierta

A pesar de que los CDC han levantado el mandato de máscara facial para aquellos que están vacunados cuando están dentro de la Iglesia no lo ha hecho. Por lo tanto, sin excepción debemos seguir estas pocas restricciones. Siendo estos todavía debemos usar una máscara facial y todavía debemos practicar el distanciamiento social.
