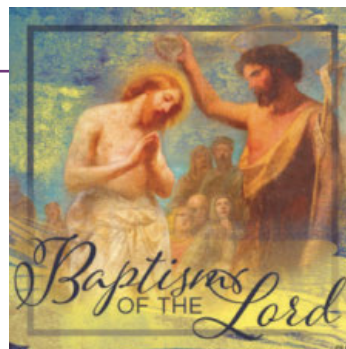
Un pensamiento para El Domingo

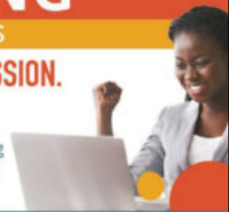
