THE SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK

On the Weekend on Feb. 9th & 10th, at all 3 Masses

The Church encourages the Anointing of the Sick to be offered around the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes, Feb. 11th. Therefore, this sacrament of healing will be offered to *those who are seriously ill and/or weakened by old age*. They will have the opportunity to be anointed at the 4pm Sat. Mass and the 8am and 10:30am Sunday Masses next weekend.

Jesus always had compassion toward the sick and performed many healings of every kind of infirmity as a sign that the Kingdom of God is at hand. Christ invites his disciples to follow him by taking up their cross of illness, and thus acquire a new outlook on human suffering due to illness and age. The Church has received this charge from the Lord and strives to carry it out by taking care of the sick, accompanying them with prayer, and offering the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick periodically.

Like all of the sacraments, Anointing of the Sick is a liturgical and communal celebration and so occasionally is offered at Mass, and so if you or someone you know is suffering from a serious illness, plan on coming or helping them come to Mass next weekend to be anointed and receive the healing power of Christ our Savior.

From the Letter of St. James 5:14-15, *"Is anyone among you sick: He should summon the priests of the church, and they should pray over him and anoint him with oil in the name of the Lord, and the prayer of faith will save the sick person, and the Lord will raise him up."*
