Here are some of the many programs and ministries that receive major funding from the A.C.A.:

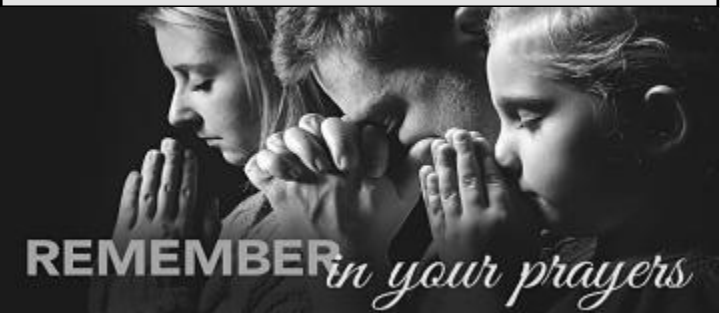

In the afternoon we will visit the Hermanhoff Winery for included wine and cheese samples and a tour of their most interesting cellars. Sit on the patio and sip wines, or visit some of the downtown Herman shops and the ice cream parlor.
