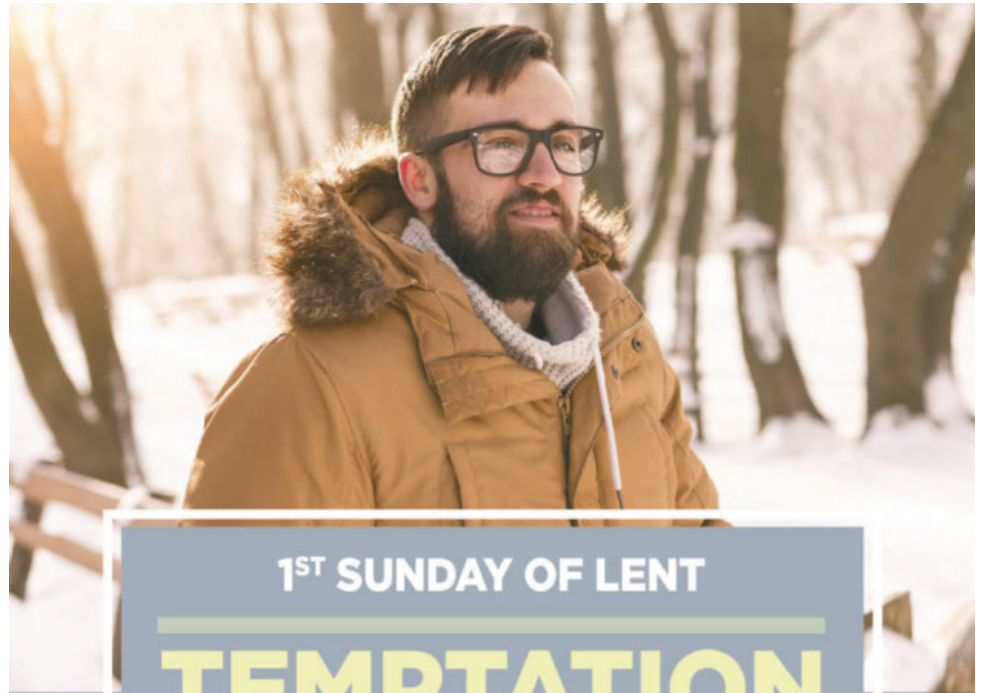

STATIONS OF THE CROSS will be held each Friday during Lent beginning at 6:00 p.m. in the Cathedral.

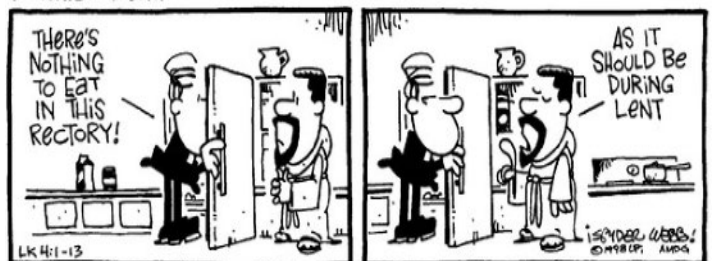

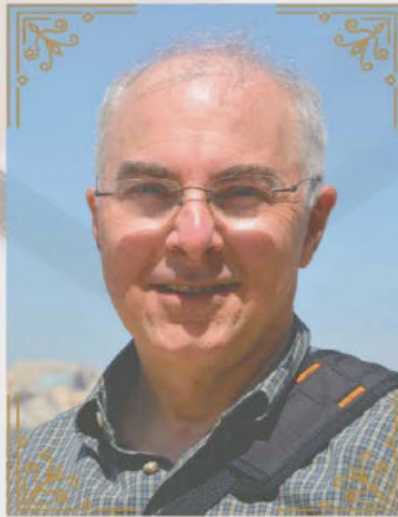
