RCIA—Have you been thinking about becoming Catholic? Maybe you want to invite your family members, friends and co-workers, and or others to explore what it means to be

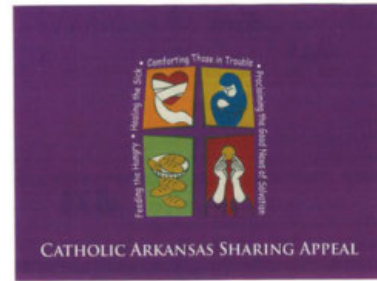

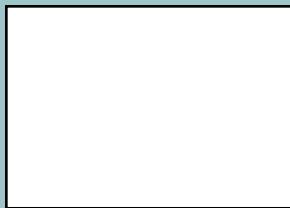

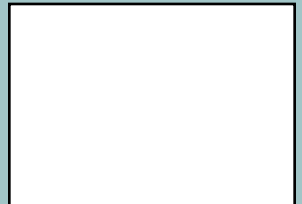
