



ABORTION AMENDMENT SIGNATURES TURNED IN

Supporters of the Arkansas Abortion Amendment proudly turned in thousands of petition pages filled with signatures. Legally, the signatures have not been verified and the heinous Amendment is not yet on our voting ballots- but July 5 was a sad day for Arkansas, because we've come one step closer to returning the evil practice of abortion to our state.

Please continue to pray that the ballot measure petition for the Arkansas Abortion Amendment will be rejected by our Secretary of State. Sadly, many of our neighbors want legal abortion. We must continue to educate everyone regarding the grave immorality of abortion and the sanctity of every human life, *from the moment of fertilization until natural death*.

If the Arkansas Abortion Amendment qualifies for the ballot, we must be prepared to vote against this change to our constitution. Those Arkansans who signed the petition will likely vote to enshrine the "right" to abortion.

Here's what we can do right now:

If you are an adult resident of Arkansas and a US citizen, be sure you are REGISTERED TO VOTE. (Are you registered? Find out here: <https://www.voterview.ar-nova.org/voterview>). Not registered yet? Find instructions here: <https://www.sos.arkansas.gov/elections/voter-information/voter-registration-information>

If you are asked to sign the petition, DO NOT SIGN IT. Canvassers may try to collect additional signatures.

Pray that the Arkansas Abortion Amendment petition will not qualify for our voting ballots.

Respect every human life at every stage across the lifespan!

Let our prayers and our actions silence the cheers of the culture of death.


