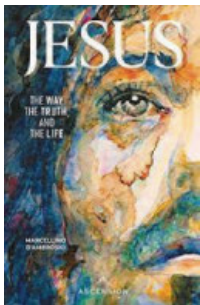
Life Long Faith Formation



The Church strictly obliges Catholics (paragraph 1285, *Lumen Gentium*) to share the faith. There are two good reasons for doing this – the first is, when we evangelize others, we evangelize ourselves. In *Redemptoris Missio*, Pope John Paul II summed up the reasoning behind that need, writing, “Faith is strengthened when it is given to others!”

How does that work? When you step out on a limb and begin to share your faith – when you make it known at work or the gym that you take your Catholic identity seriously – you will get questions. People will say things to you like “I used to be Catholic, but I don’t see why I need a priest coming between me and God” or “How can you be Catholic when the Church is so opposed to science?”

Sometimes you’ll know the answers. Other times you won’t. Hopefully if you don’t have the answer, you’ll go and find the answer to these questions. In the process of explaining the faith, you learn about the faith. *Evangelizing Catholics: A Mission Manual for the New Evangelization*, Scott Hahn

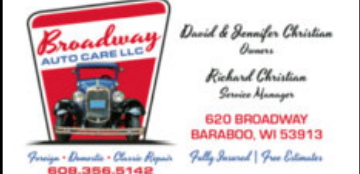
