JESUS IS RISEN EVEN AS HE SAID. The most important day in the church's annual liturgical calendar is Easter. On the annual feast of Easter at the end of forty days of Lent we celebrate the most important day in the history of the world, the day Jesus rose from the dead. We call this event the Resurrection of Jesus. We celebrate His Resurrection every Easter. Through the suffering and death of Jesus on the cross, Jesus paid the price for all the sins of all people for all time. We thank Jesus for this at every Mass in our prayers of thanks. Through the Resurrection of Jesus from the dead, Jesus gave us the gift of HOPE that our own death is not the end but is followed by the promise of eternal life. As we pray at the end of the Apostles' Creed, "we believe in the resurrection of the body and life everlasting."

Jesus died and rose from the dead to conquer sin and death forever – and to make whole and heal what is broken. Easter celebrates the ultimate victory of grace over sin, life over death, and good over evil. Jesus taught us and showed us that the path to peace and joy now and forever is His Way of self-sacrificial Love –for each of us – and for our society.

Now we begin the celebration of the Easter Season, which extends through the Feast of the Ascension of Our Lord (forty days after Easter) to the Feast of Pentecost (fifty days after Easter). As we begin the Easter Season in hope, we encourage you to continue to ask the Lord to help us see how He wants us to grow and change in the face of our current challenges.

WHAT IS IT?

Divine Mercy Sunday is a celebration of God's generous forgiveness. In the early 1900s Sister Faustina Kowalska, a Polish nun, received messages from Jesus to have the image of Divine Mercy painted and the Chaplet of Divine Mercy to be recited by the Church. This simple devotion quickly spread around the world until it was formally added to the Church's calendar in April 2000.

1. 10:15am Church Mass


ICD recently purchased a new image of Divine Mercy to be placed in the south alcove. We will inaugurate this new image in with a special blessing at the 10:15am Mass.

3. Obtain an Indulgence

A plenary indulgence is granted under the usual conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion, & prayers for the pope) to anyone who prays the Chaplet of Divine Mercy in any church or chapel on Divine Mercy Sunday. The confession can be made 20 days before or after Divine Mercy Sunday.

The Foundation is independent of the Archdiocese of St. Louis, governed by a Board of Trustees. The Foundation's structure allows for independent operating and investment decision-making, as well as the protection of assets.

Foundation assets are managed by Graystone Consulting. Graystone has more than 40 years advising not-for-profit clients as a fiduciary-backed by the resources of Morgan Stanley. All funds of the Foundation are managed in accordance with the guidelines of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops.

Immaculate Conception Catholic Church (Dardenne Prairie) Endowment Fund

Who will encounter Jesus Christ in a future yet unknown because you chose to give to the parish endowment?

The good work that is accomplished during one's lifetime does not have to end with one's passing. 


