WELCOME NEW PARISHIONERS! New Parishioner Registration Forms can be found at the front entrance of church and on our website. You may also call the Parish Office to register.

MINISTRIES - GET INVOLVED: If you are interested in one of our many ministries or wish to become involved by sharing your time or talent, please contact the Parish Office.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM: Instruction before Baptism is required. Sessions are pre-arranged with the deacon. Contact Parish Office for forms. These forms need to be filled out before meeting with the deacon. Parents need to attend, Godparents are encouraged to attend. Godparents and parents should be active in their faith and at least one Godparent should be Catholic.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION: 3:15-3:45 pm before 4:00 pm Mass or call the Parish Office for appointment.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE: Please contact the Parish Office at least 6 months prior to proposed wedding date so that preparation can be completed. No weddings on Sundays or during the six weeks of Lent.

ANNOINTING OF THE SICK: If you or a loved one is homebound, in a nursing home or hospitalized because of sickness or age, contact the Parish Office to arrange for the anointing. Because of HIPPA regulations, hospitals and nursing homes are not permitted to contact the Parish directly.

FUNERALS: Please call the Parish Office to make arrangements before publication in the newspaper.

MASS INTENTIONS: Please call the Parish Office to offer Mass Intentions.

PRAYER OF THE FAITHFUL: To add a name to the Sunday Prayer of the Faithful (sick/deceased), contact the Parish Office. Before a name can be added, you should have the approval of the affected individual or of a family member.
