

Looking for a way to get more involved at St. Paul's in the New Year?

Why not volunteer to help at Mass?

Due to COVID, construction, and other reasons, our pool of volunteers helping at Mass as Lector, Sacristan, and Hospitality has become **very small**. We need volunteers, to be able to more easily cover the weekends and assist Father during Mass.

Volunteering at Mass is such a rewarding way to serve God and support our Parish, and takes very little "extra" time out of your schedule. We will provide training and assistance in learning each of the tasks, which generally takes about 30 minutes.

The **Lector** participates in the Mass liturgy by reading scripture and leading prayer. **Sacristans** prepare the sacred vessels and elements before Mass and tend to them after, cleaning them and putting them away. **Hospitality** volunteers do just that - welcoming all those arriving for Mass, assisting with seating or any other issues, and gathering the weekly collection.
