



The Catholic Church has five precepts. The obligatory character of these positive laws is meant to guarantee to the faithful the very necessary minimum in the spirit of prayer and moral effort, in the growth in love of God and neighbor

The five Precepts of the Church are: 1) Catholics attend Mass on Sundays (or the vigil on Saturday evenings) and holy days of obligation. 2) Catholics cortess our sins at least once a year through the sacrament of reconciliation 3) Catholics receive our Creator in Holy Communion at least once during the Easter season 4) Catholics observe the prescribed days of fasting and abstinence. We fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. We abstain from meat on the Fridays of Lent, and do some penance each Friday of the year. 5) Catholics provide for the material needs of then Church, each according to his/her ability.

Heavenly Father, we thank you for the gift of Your Son Jesus Christ, who is truly present in the Eucharist. In our day, Many Catholics either do not know or do not believe that the bread and wine become Your Son Jesus, truly present to us in His Body, Blood, Soul and in His Divinity. We pray that there may be a reawakening to Christ's presence in the Eucharist, as He dwells, truly present, in all the Tabernacles throughout the world. We ask these prayers through Christ our Lord. Amen
