





The five Precepts of the Church are:

 Catholics attend Mass on Sundays (or the vigil on Saturday evenings) and holy days of obligation.
Catholics confess our sins at least once a year through the sacrament of reconciliation
Catholics receive our Creator in Holy
Communion at least once during the Easter season
Catholics observe the prescribed days of fasting and abstinence. We fast on Ash
Wednesday and Good Friday. We abstain from meat on the Fridays of Lent, and do some penance each Friday of the year.
