

### The five Precepts of the Church are:

- 1) Catholics attend Mass on Sundays (or the vigil on Saturday evenings) and holy days of obligation.
- Catholics confess our sins at least once a year through the sacrament of reconciliation
- 3) Catholics receive our Creator in Holy

Communion at least once during the Easter season

- 4) Catholics observe the prescribed days of fasting and abstinence. We fast on Ash
- Wednesday and Good Friday. We abstain from meat on the Fridays of Lent, and do some penance each Friday of the year.
- 5) Catholics provide for the material needs of the Church, each according to his/her ability.
