

The Catholic Church has five precepts. The obligatory character of these positive laws is meant to guarantee to the faithful the very necessary minimum in the spirit of prayer and moral effort, in the growth in love of God and neighbor

The five Precepts of the Church are:

 Catholics attend Mass on Sundays (or the vigil on Saturday evenings) and holy days of obligation.
Catholics confess our sins at least once a year through the sacrament of reconciliation
Catholics receive our Creator in Holy Communion at least once during the Easter season
Catholics observe the prescribed days of fasting and abstinence. We fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. We abstain from meat on the Fridays of Lent, and do some penance each Friday of the year.
Catholics provide for the material needs of the Church, each according to his/her ability.

ADULT & YOUTH-FAITH FORMATION

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

program at St. Paul's guides people on a journey of faith-one that involves our whole community. It's a program for those seeking to develop or deepen their relationship with Jesus Christ. The RCIA process is a series of carefully planned stages, marked by liturgical rites in the presence of the whole community, in which new Catholics embark on and join us in a continuing and deepening conversion into faith and discipleship. The RCIA process is divided into four phases to help the seeker, candidate or catechumen, in their Christian formation. Presentations focus on the Catholic Church's teaching regarding: sacraments, liturgy, social justice, conscience formation and morality, Mary, the saints, sacred scripture, prayer, and much more.
