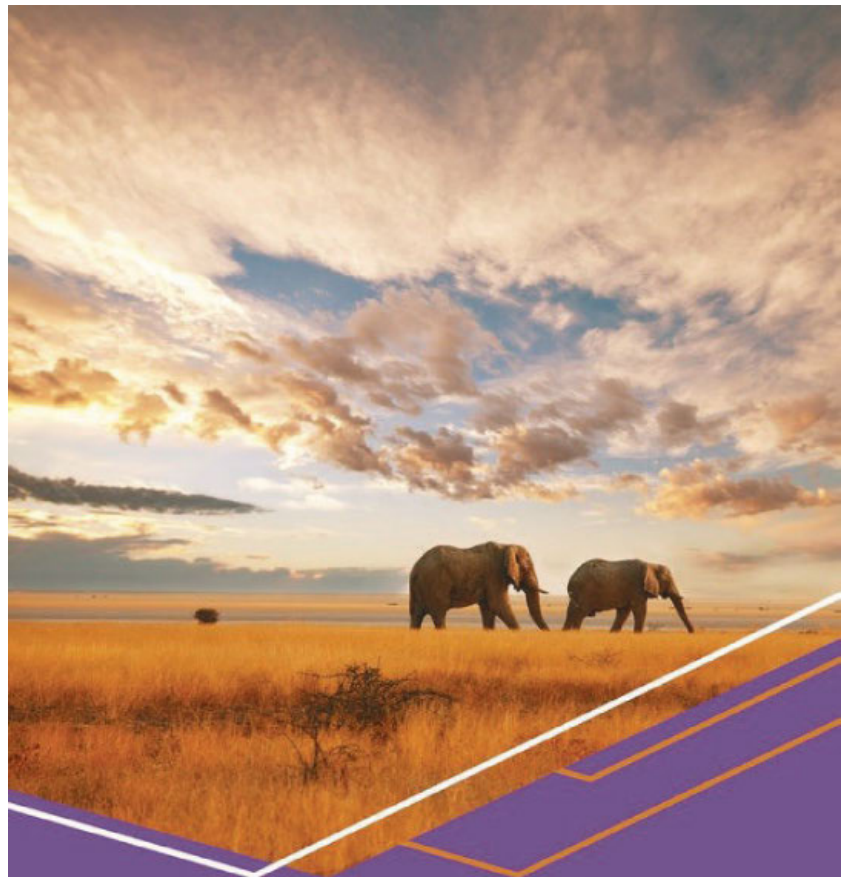

JOB OPPORTUNITY GREENCASTLE, IN THE WATERS OF GREENCASTLE

WHO: Student OR retired OR in between who might be interested in healthcare—seeing a bit of the inside, at least from the nursing home view; and, those students who need work hours to fulfill their senior experience requirement and/or intend to do CNA training; OR senior adults and in between ages who wish to serve another.

WHAT and WHEN: HELPER—Assisting/feeding a dementia resident the evening meal, and on weekends the noon meal as well. For helpers who have daytime hours free, five noon meals each week are available.

Time of the noon meal is approximately noon - 1 p.m. Evening meal is approximately 5 - 6 p.m.

WHERE: The Waters of Greencastle, 1601 Hospital Drive, Greencastle, IN.

DETAILS: Sit beside the 73-year-old gentleman in the facility dining room, use the spoon and/ or fork provided, feed him the meal. Assist him in holding the glass to drink his water. Help him avoid any messes—snap the clothing protector/napkin on prior to beginning the meal. Make sure the wheelchair is in the upright position—moving it very carefully so as not to alarm the resident, etc.

EMPLOYMENT: Generous hourly rate paid Sunday evenings for the previous week, including Sunday. Preferred payment through Zelle (instant deposit). Require completed W9 for income tax reporting (provided at training). CNA certification NOT required; this is a private hire. Training provided by spouse of the resident with the resident during an actual meal—one hour paid training. **WHO MAY APPLY:** Only those who are dependable, reliably available, consistent, gentle in care, and patient in challenging situations. Meal helper should be intuitive and personable, willing to speak with other residents and all staff members.

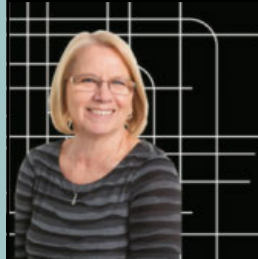

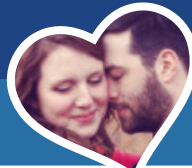
