

It Takes All Kinds

"If every flower wanted to be a rose," wrote St. Therese of Lisieux, "spring would lose its loveliness."

Bishop David J. Malloy advised priests of the Diocese of Rockford in a June 11 letter, that the dispensation from the obligation of attending Mass on

Sundays and holy days of obligation was to be lifted on July 1, 2021. As the dispensation is now lifted, Catholics are reminded in the days and months ahead to use their consciences for any decision about not attending Mass or continuing to follow it virtually and to ask for pastoral guidance from their parish priests if needed.

Also, in accordance with Bishop Malloy's letter of August 27, 2021, ...all individuals, regardless of vaccination status, age two and older and able to tolerate a face covering...are required to cover their nose and mouth with a face covering when indoors on the premises of our churches, schools, and Diocesan facilities.
