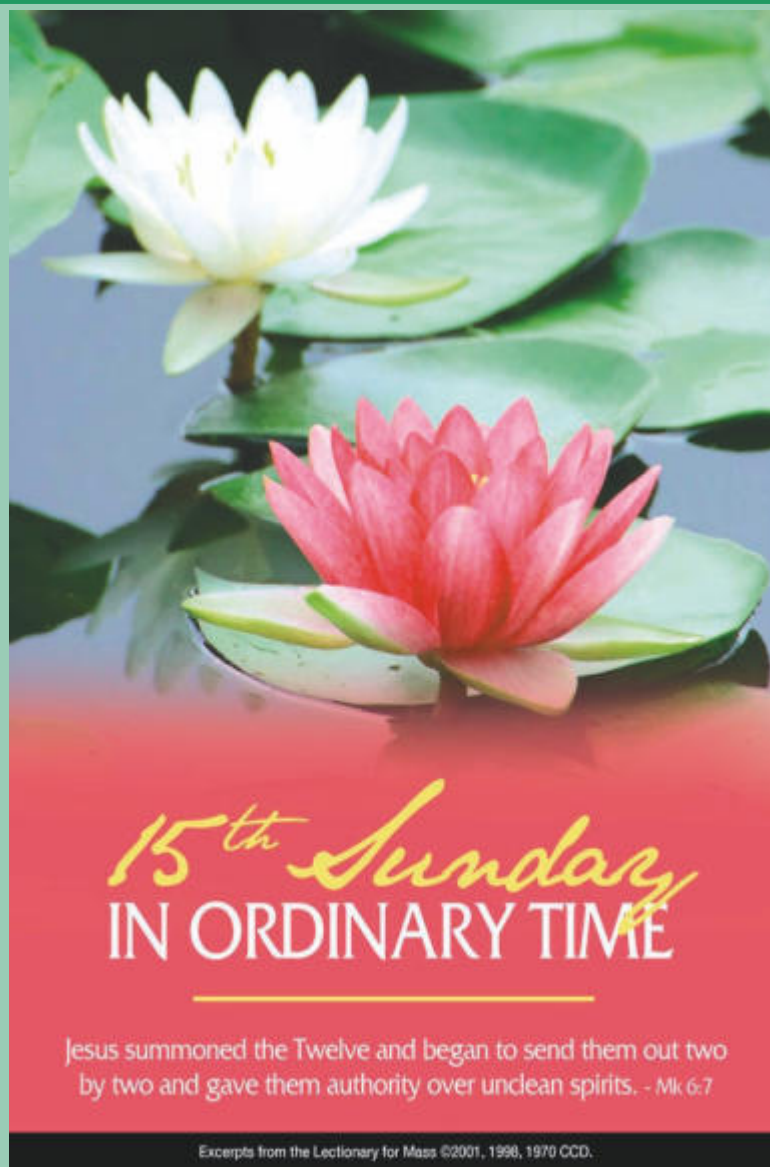

### Inspiration for the week

We cannot just accept the wisdom of the world as true and conduct our lives as if the Good News is a separate matter. They are one. When the rubber meets the road and the message is challenging, rejection is quite possible. That's the litmus test for whether we're really doing what we have been asked.

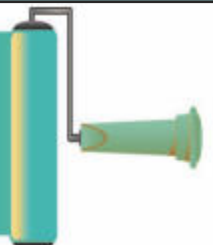
