Deacons Corner

Q. Deacon Mike, a Lutheran friend of mine told me that Lutherans believe in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist in the same way that Catholics do. They just explain it differently. Is that true?

A. No, it is not true. Lutherans believe in consubstantiation while we Catholics believe in transubstantiation. Lutherans believe that, after the consecration, the substances of both the body and blood of Jesus and the bread and wine remain. The body and blood are "with the substance" (consubstantial) of the bread and wine, sitting right next to them, so to speak. Transubstantiation is quite different. It is the belief that the whole substance of bread and wine is converted (literally changed) into the whole substance of the Body and Blood of Christ, with only the appearance (the accidents, as theologians like to say) of the bread and wine remaining. Consubstantiation means that the Eucharist consists of the body and blood of Jesus plus the bread and wine. Transubstantiation means that only the Body and Blood are present, although the appearances of bread and wine remain as sacramental symbols of earthly food. The term transubstantiation was decided upon (in 1215 at the Fourth Lateran Council) as the only term which completely and accurately describes the mystery of the Real Presence. Other terms are either incomplete or simply wrong. While consubstantiation affirms the real presence of Jesus, only transubstantiation does true justice to the biblical teaching regarding Christ's presence as well as the tradition and practice of the early Church fathers regarding the Eucharist. 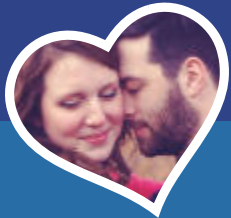
Holy Rosary
