#### FROM THE PASTOR'S KEYBOARD:

The prophets are not always prophetic, as in telling what will happen. In the Bible, some passages of the prophets say "this will happen." More often the prophets actually say "if you don't change your behavior, this will happen." The prophets' main job is to communicate God's will. In the daily life of the prophets, the stuff that wasn't written down, they likely worked as advisors and judges of divine things. Many of the pagan neighbors of the Old Testament Jews had soothsayers or others who revealed the future. God banned such practices from among the Jews. The prophets were not like fortune tellers who answered your questions, but folks who were responsible for asking God's questions.

The prophets were not mere teachers, and God often asked them to reveal his teachings in dramatic ways. The prophetic books are full of vibrant imagery. Sometimes prophets were asked to do something crazy to get people's attention. One of the strangest of these actions was several prophets were asked to have kids and name them special names, names that were basically a whole phrase, "Not My People." The prophet Isaiah was even asked to have a kid and name him a specific thing as a prophetic action.

In today's first reading, Isaiah evokes that image of naming a child to describe how God is going to restore Israel. When this passage was written, the cities were all destroyed and the remaining Jewish intellectuals and religious officials were all slaves in Babylon. After 70 years in Babylon, there is now an opportunity to go back and attempt to rebuild the city, a new birth. This rebirth is their "vindication." The people will have a new name, "my delight."

Not only is the rebuilding of Israel a rebirth, it is an engagement as well. The old Israel, lost to Babylon's armies, had never reached it's fulfillment. God is proposing to marry, be with, the new Israel. This is the invitation Isaiah is shouting out to the people. Step away from your comfortable slave life. His audience was Jewish bureaucrats in Babylon with lives vastly more comfortable than the average person, even if in a sort of slavery. He tells them "come be reborn" and be with God in the deepest intimacy.

#### ST. VINCENT DE PAUL

Second Sunday in Ordinary Time: In the Gospel today, at the wedding feast in Cana, Jesus reveals himself to his disciples and they began to believe in him. Everyday, God also gives us signs of his love and so we also can respond in faith and trust.
