From the Pastor's Keyboard:

This weekend, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Epiphany of Our Lord. Epiphany is a Greek word meaning "to shine over". We use the word in reference to the light over the whole world revealing the reality of God becoming human. This is signified by the three magi coming to visit the Holy Family. These three magi (in Latin meaning "authority"-this is where the word "Magisterium" comes) represent the whole civilized world. It's not quite clear who these three were. Since the word 'magi" is used, it was thought they were kings or at least educated men. Traditionally, the names given were Caspar, Melchior and Balthasar, and these are venerated as saints of the Church. Regardless of who these three are, they recognized something significant had happened in human history-God has become human, and hence a king is born to free us from tyranny of sin.


