#### BACKGROUND ON NEXT WEEK'S READINGS

#### THE EPIPHANY JANUARY 1ST/2ND

#### First Reading: Isaiah 60: 1-6

The last part of the book of Isaiah contains the words of a prophet who lived after the Jews returned from exile in Babylon (which is modern day Iraq). They found their temple destroyed and the city leveled. But with great faith and prophet envisions a wonderful future for Jerusalem.

#### Second Reading: Ephesians 3: 2-3, 5-6

The Ephesians were a community in which Jewish converts to Christianity lived side-by-side with Gentile converts. The author of this letter confirms that God's saving grace is available to everyone, whatever their background.


