BACKGROUND ON NEXT WEEK'S READINGS FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME JANUARY 29TH/30TH

First Reading: Jeremiah 1: 4-5, 17-19

Next week we hear about Jeremiah's call to be a prophet. It came when he was quite young. It also came at a time of turmoil when Babylon was in the process of conquering the entire Near East. That's why Jeremiah felt uneasy about the call. God, however, refuses to take "no" for an answer.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 12: 31, 13:13

We will recognize next week's passage from First Corinthians as one that is often read at weddings. Actually, the context is not marriage, but squabbles in the Christian community in Corinth over whose spiritual gifts were most important. Paul goes to the heart of the matter.




