## Liturgy Corner

### **BACKGROUND ON NEXT WEEK'S READINGS**

#### **FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT APRIL 2ND/3RD**

#### **First Reading: Isaiah 43: 16-21**

This section of the book of Isaiah contains the words of a prophet who addressed God's people exiled in Babylon (located in modern-day Iraq). He encourages them that one day they will be free to return home to Jerusalem. This journey will be through the desert, but God will transform this barren wasteland to ease their passage home.

#### **Second Reading: Philippians 3: 8-14**

The city of Philippi was located in what is today northeastern Greece, a country where Olympic-type games were popular. Paul draws upon this image to motivate the people to keep pressing forward in their spiritual growth.

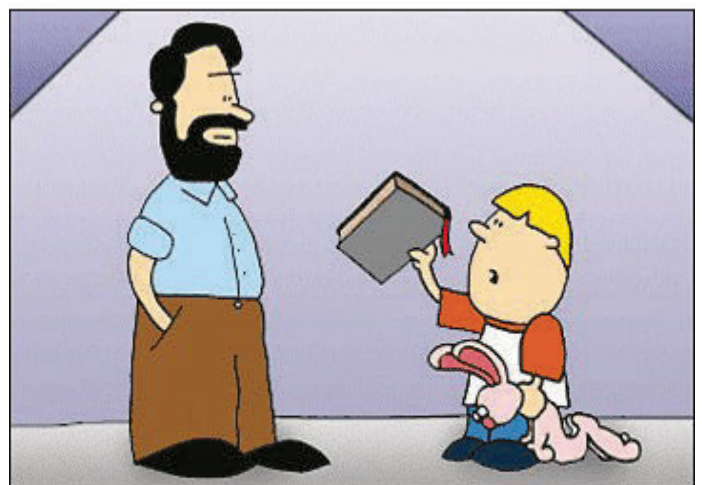

## Dynamic Catholic, *Alive!*

### Live as a New Creation

In the second reading Paul tells us that God has “reconciled us to himself through Christ.” Because of this grace, Christ has given us the gift of making each of us a new creation. This week would be a great time during your Lenten journey to take some time to ponder how we are using that gift. Have we allowed Christ to work through us, so that we can be ambassadors for Him? Have we remained reconciled to Christ? To be an ambassador we need to spread the good news. That doesn’t necessarily mean sharing the doctrine of our faith. We need to share our own relationship with Christ with others. How do you do that? Through the grace of the Holy Spirit we can allow people to see and hear Christ through us. We can share with others what Jesus has done in our own lives and what knowing Jesus means to us. Can you leave your comfort zone to live as a new creation?

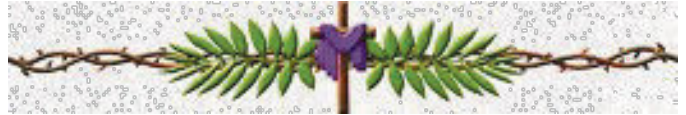
