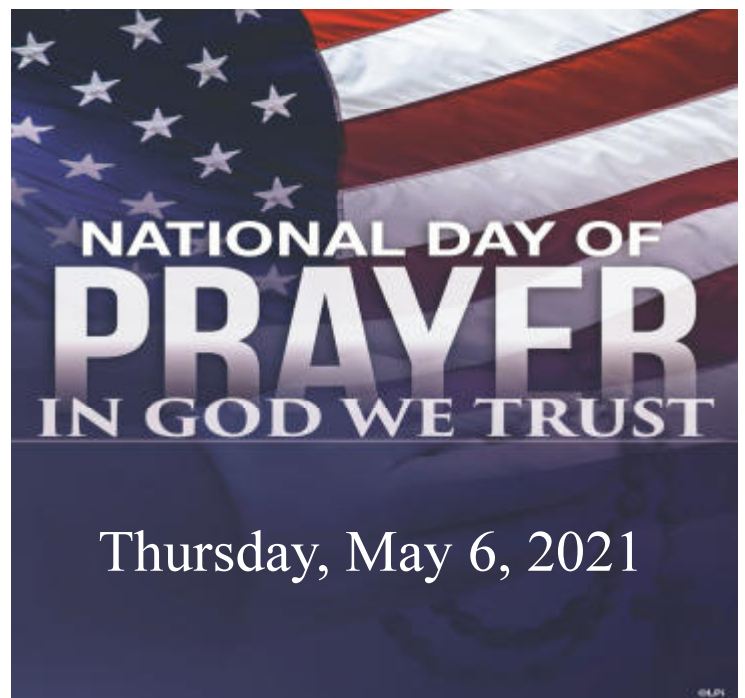
**Christ the King Mother's Day Out is now registering for the 2021-2022 school year!**

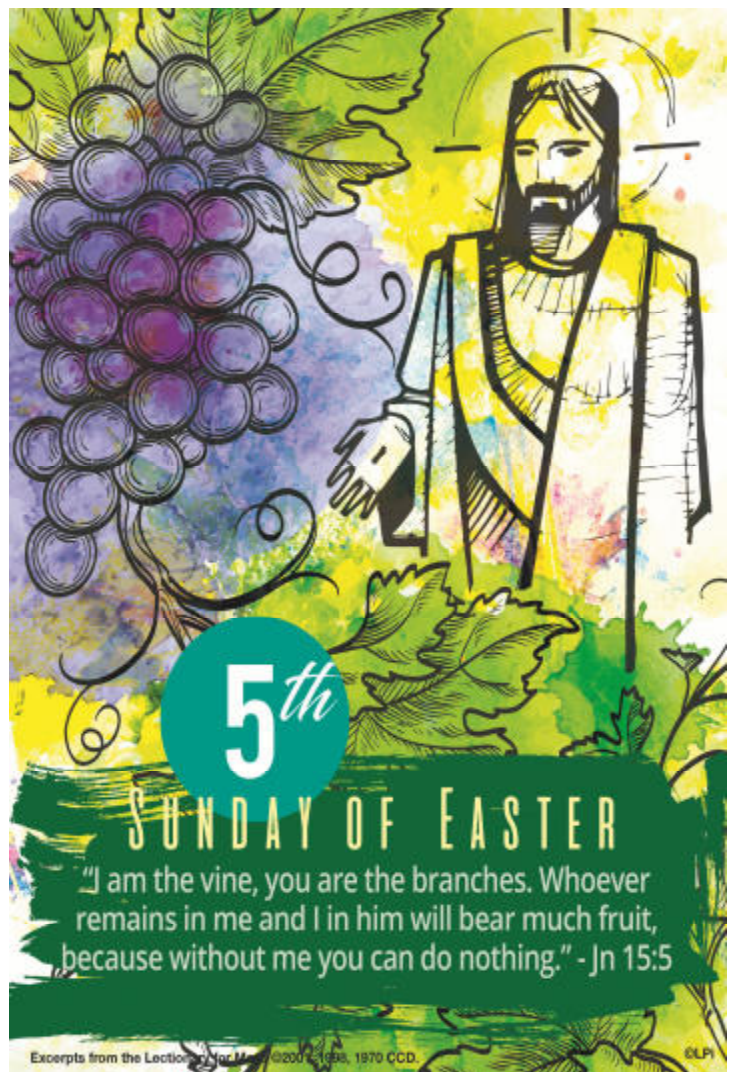
