
As the New Year approaches we are restructuring our dine-in program.







CITY OF MANITOWOC Tree for a Tree Program



In an effort to help Manitowoc residents regain some of the urban canopy which will be lost due to the Emerald Ash Borer's devastating effects on our cities Ash Tree population, the City of Manitowoc Forestry Division will offer a Christmas Tree Exchange Program. The Tree for a Tree Program will offer city residents the opportunity to exchange a live Christmas tree for a young deciduous tree seedling known in forestry as a "whip." Whips are generally between three to four feet in height and two to four years of age ready for planting.

Throughout the month of January 2022 City of Manitowoc residents will have the opportunity to bring their live Christmas tree to the Manitowoc County Recycling site located at 3000 Basswood Road and receive a voucher for a deciduous whip (one voucher per resident please). Live trees should be free of stands, decorations, bags, tinsel, lights etc. Participants will need to come during the main office hours, Monday – Friday between 7 am and 4 pm. Participants should get their voucher before dropping their tree off.

Vouchers will be redeemable from April 15, 2022 through May 31, 2022 at Silver Creek Nursery located at 1909 Silver Creek Road, Manitowoc, WI. Participation is restricted to City of Manitowoc residents and on a "first come, first served" basis as quantities will be limited.


