If you have not yet registered in Servant Keeper, you'll choose the 'haven't registered yet' option, then enter your family email address and a password. You may also email your current contact information to bookkeeper@sacredhearteureka.org for updating.

We hope that with these options, parishioners will receive their statements in a timely manner and have their statements on hand when needed for tax purposes. In addition, it will save our parish considerably in printing, postage, and time.


## Women's Club Chicken Soup for the Soul

## So you're thinking about getting Married

## **Congratulations!**

We are excited for you and for your families! Your commitment to love one another forever is a sign of hope for the world. Your request to be married in the community of the Church is a sign of faith.

## Where Do We Start?

You start by emailing Kristy at the Parish Office—parishsecretary@sacredhearteureka.org. We can then reply with the Wedding Intake form so that we might receive from you some basic information, and explain the process to you.

## When Should We Call?

Generally as soon as the two of you have decided to get married, preferably a year or more in advance, and before you schedule a hall. (Note that marriage dates are only tentative until after pre marriage assessment work is completed.)

## Who Can Get Married At Most Sacred Heart Church?

To be married at Most Sacred Heart, at least one party must be a registered member of Most Sacred Heart Parish and be living an active and practicing Catholic life.

## When Can A Wedding Be Scheduled?

Weddings at Most Sacred Heart may be celebrated on most Fridays and Saturdays of the year, except during Lent. Weddings may be scheduled on Friday evenings, or on Saturdays at either 11:00 am or 1:30 pm.

## **Final Message**

Yes, there is much to plan, and a lot to prepare. But we pray that — through it all — you will keep a place in your heart for what really matters. For your wedding is a day; your marriage is forever. The time you spend now talking, praying, forgiving and working on your relationship, sets the ground work for a holy and life giving marriage: in good times and in bad, in sickness and in health, all the days of your life.

## **EPIPHANY HOME BLESSING**

A custom during Epiphany is to bless one's home. The numbers stand for the year in which the blessing is inscribed (2022). The letters stand for the names traditionally given the Magi who found the Christ Child: Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar. They are also an abbreviation for the Latin blessing: Christus mansionem benedicat, or "Christ bless this house."

This year's mark above the doorway is: 20 + C + M + B + 22. Below is an Epiphany home blessing for you to follow.

## BLESSING:

Gather at the front door of your home. Mark, with chalk, above the door with the initials of the Magi and the code of the current year. (20+C+M+B+22). Together, make the sign of the cross.

**Leader:** "Let us praise God, who fills our hearts and homes with peace. Blessed be God forever." **All:** "Blessed be God forever."

**Reader:** "The Magi were thrilled and excited to see the star. When the men went into the house and saw the child with Mary, his mother, they knelt and worshiped him." (Matthew 2:10-11)

**Leader:** "Lord God of heaven and earth, You revealed Your Son, Jesus, to every nation by the guidance of a star. Bless this house and all who inhabit it. Fill us with the light of Christ, and may we all do our best to reflect Your love in this world. We ask this through Christ, our Lord." **All:** "Amen."

(If you happen to have some Holy water readily available, you may sprinkle some on your door now.)


