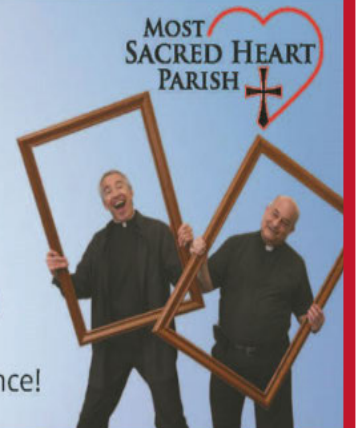

 - Be mindful of your prayer postures, find a meaningful focus
- **GIVE:** Look for ways to give to the poor or serve others
 - Donate to the Eureka Food Pantry, either directly at the Eureka Food Pantry or drop in the collection basket in the back of Church
 - Donate your clean, gently used clothing and unbreakable household items to SVdP using the blue SVdP 'Donation for a Neighbor' bin located near the Rectory
 - Offer your time in service to the parish by getting trained as a **Eucharistic Minister + Lector + Usher/Greeter + AV Technician**

 - Fast from pressures and be prayerful
