

#### **Prepare For Next Sunday's Readings**

In next Sunday's Gospel, (January 9) the Baptism of the Lord, our Gospel reading tells us that we hear John the Baptist address the confusion of the people who thought that John might be the Messiah. In response, John contrasts the baptism that he performs with the Baptism that Jesus will inaugurate. John the Baptist says that he has baptized with water, but that someone will come and baptize with the Holy Spirit. The type of baptism that John performed was not vet a Christian Baptism; it was a preparation for Christian Baptism through which sins are forgiven and the gift of the Holy Spirit is received. The baptism of Jesus is considered a manifestation of God in Jesus, another "epiphany." On this, the last day of the Christmas season, our Gospel reveals to us Jesus' relation to God: the son of Mary and Joseph is also God's own Son. We, the children of Adam and Eve, are again made children of God through Baptism.



#### A Pilgrim's Progress....

Today we anticipate the 12<sup>th</sup> day of Christmas with our celebration of the Epiphany. It is a Greek word meaning to reveal. As we celebrate the manifestation of God in Christ to the gentile nations through the magi we are challenged to be revelations of Christ in our own lives as well.

As the children of Israel were saved that first Passover by marking the lintels of their homes (horizontal beam atop their front door) with the blood of the lamb, we mark our doors with the Epiphany blessing reminding all who pass through of the intercession of the magi and Christ's blessing on our lives and homes. The magi's initials +C+M+B+ can also remind us of the Latin phrase Christus Mansionem Benedicat (May Christ Bless this House).

The gifts the magi presented before the Word Made Flesh can also challenge us to live our lives as a gift to Jesus Christ and make the Lord present to others. Gold, was a gift "fit for a king." It was highly valued, yet pure and simple as well. In a similar way our faith must be constantly "refined," as we strive to conform our lives to the Word of God and not manipulate God's Word to rationalize our choices.

The Christ child was given frankincense in recognition of his priesthood. The chief among the council of priests in ancient Rome was known as the pontifex. This became another title for the pope. In Latin pontifex means "bridge builder." As the Sacraments are God's bridge connecting us to His divine life, our fidelity to the Sacramental life empowers us to witness more faithfully each day.

The gift of myrrh, used to help prepare the physical body for burial, reminds us that the Christ child was born to suffer and die for each of us. Epiphany reminds us that the cross never stands very far from the crib. As St. Rose of Lima reminded us, it is the only ladder by which you and I can climb to Heaven.

Just as the magi, eluded the evil plans of King Herod, so you and I can be messengers of hope and peace in this new year by keeping our lives focused on the Light of Jesus Christ. Sail On, fr john
