The Catholic-Jewish Conference of Milwaukee has organized a winter clothing drive for the benefit of our Afghan brothers and sisters at Ft. McCoy.

Within the Jewish tradition the phrase ‘Tikkun Olam’ (Repairing the World), is used to remind all the faithful that it is our communal responsibility to fix what is wrong with the world.

In the Gospel of Matthew, we read:  
“I was a stranger and you welcomed me,  
I was naked and you gave me clothing.

‘Truly I tell you, just as you did it to one of the least of these who are members of my family, you did it to me.’  
(Matthew 25:35-40)

Most of the refugees at Ft. McCoy are under the age of 18 and need small to medium sized clothing. Also, there is a need for infant clothes. An average of 9 infants are birthed every month.

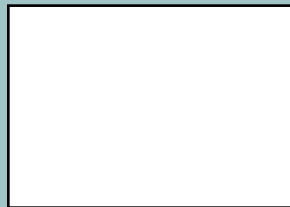

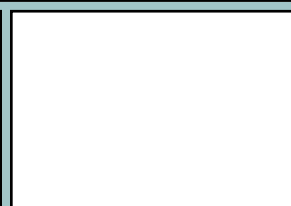
